Probable Cause

On August 25th, 2019 at approximately 2:30am, I was in service in Palm Beach County, Florida. I was stationary on the southbound entrance ramp to Interstate 95 (State Road 9) from Southern Boulevard (State Road 80). I observed a white in color Ford F-150 Crew Cab Pickup truck traveling Northbound Interstate 95 (State Road 9) south of Southern Boulevard (State Road 80) in the far right lane driving on 3 tires and one rim sparking and grinding the roadway. I then advised that Lake Worth Regional Communication Center that the vehicle was continuing Northbound and I was going to turn around at Forest Hill Blvd (State Road 882). The vehicle matched the description of a vehicle which had fled from Jupiter Police Department as well as Palm Beach Gardens. Lake Worth Regional Communication Center also advised that both departments had utilized their stop sticks in an attempt to stop the vehicle. Both agencies advised that they had lost visual of the vehicle but it was last seen traveling southbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9).

A Palm Beach Gardens Officer who had attempted to initiate a traffic stop on the vehicle stated that he had ran the vehicle's license plate and was able to identify the driver as that registered owner of the vehicle. Reference Palm Beach Gardens Police Department Case# 19-005017.

I caught up white in color Ford F-150 Crew Cab Pickup truck and began to pace the vehicle in my Florida Highway Patrol Marked Patrol Vehicle (1438) at 55mph in a 65mph zone. The vehicle then increased speed to approximately 110mph. I continued to follow and pace the vehicle which was traveling in the inside center lane still driving on a rim. I advised other units of my current location to wait for more backup units to assist in attempting a traffic stop. While traveling north, the vehicle made multiple lane changes with varying speeds.

Once other units were closer to attempt to initiate a traffic stop, the suspect vehicle the exited Interstate 95 (State Road 9), on the Westbound PGA Blvd (State Road 786) exit. I then activated my emergency lights and siren in an attempt to initiate a traffic stop. The vehicle then began to increase speed and failed to pullover. The vehicle then began to travel westbound on PGA Blvd (State Road 786) running

the red light at Military Trail (State Road 809) and continuing westbound at a high rate of speed, traveling over 100mph in a posted 45mph zone. While traveling westbound I continued to maintain visual of the vehicle in the distance. The suspect vehicle made it the intersection of Beeline Hwy (State Road 710) and PGA Blvd (State Road 786). Once I arrived at the intersection I observed that they vehicle made a right, traveling westbound on Beeline Hwy (State Road 710), west of PGA Blvd (State Road 786). I then observed the suspect vehicle had traveled westbound in the eastbound travel lanes traveling, the opposite way of traffic, then ran off the roadway in the unpaved grass shoulder into standing water. The vehicle's front driver door was open and the vehicle was unoccupied. Sgt. Matthew Gallagher ID#1176 and I were out with the unoccupied vehicle and established a perimeter on the grass shoulder just north of the railroad tracks and tree line. While out with the vehicle waiting for K-9 Trooper Sean Laljie and additional units. It was at that time a white male, wearing blue jeans which appeared wet, gray sneakers, and no shirt, appeared from the opposite side of the railroad tracks. Due to the fact that the area in which we were in was desolate, with no other access to the area other than Beeline Hwy (State Road 710). The white male was believed to be the driver of the vehicle. The driver was then instructed come toward Sgt. Gallagher and myself with his hands up. The driver appeared to be unbalanced while walking towards us. Once the male was close enough he was taken into custody without incident. I observed an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from the driver's person when making contact.

The License plate on the vehicle was ran through dispatch, TAG# KEKQ84, and came back to the white Ford Pickup which was ran through FCIC/NCIC and was not missing or stolen. The Registered owner of the vehicle came back to a PEARCE WILLIAM SABATES. I then asked the white male for his name to which he advised his name was PEARCE WILLIAM SABATES and that he was the registered owner of the truck. While speaking with the driver I observed that he had glassy watery eyes.

Due to the circumstances and safety reasons, SABATES was not asked to perform roadside field sobriety exercises.

SABATES was taken into custody and transported to the Palm Beach County Jail. SABATES was subsequently charged with violation of F.S.S. 316.1935(3)- Fleeing and Eluding a Police Officer due to the fact that he failed stop when I attempted to conducted a traffic stop in my ASSIGNED MARKED FLORIDA HIGHWAY PATROL VEHICLE (4138) with willful and wanton disregard for the motoring public while traveling at high rates of speed on roadways near other drivers and running red illuminated traffic lights in addition to other moving violations. SABATES was charged SABATES was charged with violation of F.S.S. 316.193(1)- Driving Under the Influence of either an unknown alcoholic beverage or controlled substance based off of the totality of the circumstances. SABATES was charged with violation of F.S.S. 843.02- Resisting Officer without Violence due to the fact that he fled the scene on foot after running from the vehicle when it was no longer drivable. SABATES was also issued multiple citations, and his vehicle was towed from the scene.

While at the breath testing facility, SABATES was read implied consent and was requested to provide samples of his breath in order to determine the alcohol content, to which he stated that he would do the breath test. Then as the breath technician explained the process, SABATES refused. SABATES was reminded of this and the consequence were clarified to him. He then refused again. SABATES was read her Miranda Rights and stated that he understood his rights. With his rights in mind SABATES agreed to answered the questions I had for him from the issued PBSO Q & A sheet turned in with the

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arrest packet to the jail.

My in-car video was activated to capture the driving pattern and encounter with SABATES.

The above incident occurred in Palm Beach County, Florida.
