Probable Cause

On August 11, 2019 at approximately 2:15am. I was in service in Palm Beach County, Florida. I was dispatched by the Lake Worth Regional Communication Center and responded to the area of Northbound Interstate 95 (State Road 9), south of Boynton Beach Blvd (State Road 804) on the paved east shoulder in reference to a Hit and Run Crash. When I arrived on scene, I observed a Black in color Toyota Camry with damage to the rear with what appeared to be white paint transfer from the suspect vehicle. I spoke with the driver and passenger of the vehicle to which they advised that they were struck from behind while driving Northbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9) in the center lane by a white vehicle. The victim had originally left the scene and stated that he was unable to call law enforcement to report the accident due to the fact that his phone battery was dead but did buy a charger to call law enforcement. A witness who observed the accident did follow the vehicle and advised Lake Worth Regional Communication Center of the suspect vehicle and tag#. Boynton Beach Police was also able to obtain dashcam footage of the crash which occurred.

I was advised by the Lake Worth Regional Communication Center that Boynton Beach Police Department was out with a vehicle matching the description of the suspect vehicle and matching license plate number (Tag# RIKAB). I was advised that Boynton Beach Police Department did have the suspect vehicle stopped which had front end damage with black paint transfer from the victim's vehicle. After clearing the scene with the victim's vehicle I met with the Boynton Beach Police Department who had stopped the suspect vehicle and detained the driver due to the fact that she had failed to stop once they attempted to make a traffic stop in reference to a Be On Look Out (BOLO) which was put out for the vehicle from the Hit and Run.

Once I arrived on Scene I made contact with Boynton Beach Police Officer A. Shephaum ID#924, who stated that she was in service in her marked police vehicle she observed a white in color Nissan traveling on Old Boynton Road with front end damage matching the description of the suspect vehicle with was involved in a vehicle crash on Interstate 95 (State Road 9). I conducted an interview on Camera with Officer A. Shephaum ID#924 for her statement in reference to establishing driving pattern which she observed from the suspect vehicle. Reference Boynton Beach Police Department Case# 19-045028 for Officer A. Shephaum's incident report. Officer A. Shephaum did advise me the suspect was placed into handcuffs and only being detained because she failed to stop as well as has already fled the scene of an accident. I then made contact with the suspect, PURVANI BHAGWANDEEN, who was now in front of my patrol car being read her Miranda Rights. I advised BHAGWANDEEN that I was conducting a Crash Investigation to find out about the traffic crash which occurred on Interstate 95 (State Road 9). BHAGWANDEEN stated that she was driving on Interstate 95 (State Road 9) on her way home. BHAGWANDEEN stated that she was traveling in the center lane at around 70 to 75mph when she observed a vehicle cut her off. BHAGWANDEEN stated that she did hit the rear-end the victim's vehicle because she was unable to slow enough to avoid collision.

I then advised BHAGWANDEEN that I was done with my crash investigation and moving on to a

criminal investigation to determine if the driver was driving under the Influence. While talking to BHAGWANDEEN I observed she was having slight difficulty maintaining her balance as well as glassy watery eyes. I also smelled the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from BHAGWANDEEN's breath. While talking with BHAGWANDEEN, she continuously would talk over me as I was explaining that I was going to be requesting her to perform some standardized field sobriety exercises. BHAGWANDEEN also stated many times that that she lived just around the corner and was just trying to get home to her 8-week old child who was at home with BHAGWANDEEN's mother. I explained to BHAGWANDEEN that if she did not perform the task then I would have to base my decision on the totality of the circumstances. BHAGWANDEEN then agreed to perform the tasks.

Observation-

Subject was having a difficult time keeping head still during task. I also observed that the driver had glassy eyes. Subject had equal tracking and equal pupil size. Odor of unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from the Subject's breath. Subject also stopped following the light and looked at me instead of following the light.

Walk and Turn-

Subject could not keep her balance while listening to instructions and came out of starting position. Subject attempted to begin exercise before instructed to do so. Subject missed walking heel-to-toe multiple times. Subject stepped off the line on both times she walked down the line. Subject turned improperly while almost losing her balance. Subject took improper number of steps, exceeding 10 steps on both passes as well as failed to count steps aloud.

Observation-

Subject failed to maintain her balance almost appearing as if she was likely to fall down. Almost tripped over curve which was behind her while attempting to transition to next task instructional phase.

One-Leg Stand-

Subject Swayed while balancing. Subject put foot down before being told to do so. Subject put her foot down multiple times stating that she has a hard time balancing.

This incident occurred in Palm Beach County, Florida.




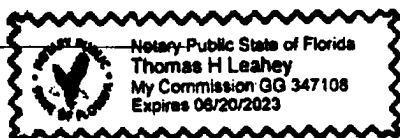
