
While on patrol heading southbound at the 1400 block of South Seacrest Blvd, (Boynton Beach, Florida) I observed a silver Mazda CX-7 (FL Tag 876-TPS) traveling south bound on S. Seacrest Blvd. The vehicle entered a clearly marked/painted crosswalk at the intersection of Woolbright Road and S. Seacrest Blvd., and came to a stop within the crosswalk, thus obstructing pedestrian traffic that had to walk around the vehicle as a result. While driving southbound I also observed that the left rear tail light was cracked and exhibiting a white light from within the tail light housing. I conducted a traffic stop of the vehicle based on the observed traffic infractions. It should be noted that any and all references to Narcotics/Controlled Substances in the following report are based on my knowledge, training, and experience in conducting Narcotics/Contraband Investigations.

I made contact with the driver, later identified by FL DL as Austin Baehr, I then asked Baehr for his driving documents. While Baehr looked for those items I observed several clear plastic bags containing a green leaf like substance (residue), resembling suspect marijuana, scattered in the front driver side cabin of the vehicle (Floorboard, Cupholder). Due to the smell of Marijuana and the Paraphernalia I ordered Baehr out of the vehicle and arrested him for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (F.S.S. 893.147.1). Ofc. Dominguez who was also on scene, observed the rear passenger in the vehicle later identified as H/M Alexander Claudio making furtive movements attempting to hide a plastic wrapper containing several yellow pills, inside of the rear pouch compartment on the back of the front passenger seat. It should be noted that the wrapper had no prescription labeling on it at all. Claudio was ordered out of the vehicle and the wrapper with the (21) round yellow pills was retrieved. The pills were identified through Poison Control as Cyclobenzaprine, which is a Prescription Drug/Non Scheduled medication. Claudio was charged with Possession of Certain Drugs W/O Prescription (F.S.S. 499.03.1). W/F Rachael Mollenkopf was ordered to exit the vehicle to enable us to conduct an Inventory Search of the vehicle prior to Tow.

During the inventory search, I located a multi color plastic device "marijuana grinder" and a blue and yellow pipe in the front passenger seat that was in an area where only Mollenkopf would have had access to. I also located a black bookbag in the front passenger seat that Mollenkopf utterly stated that it belonged to her. Inside of the bookbag were (5) clear silver plastic baggies containing sublingual strips with Cannabis extract listed as the main active ingredient. I tested the suspect cannabis extract utilizing a Duquenois Levine Reagent test kit; which yielded a positive result for the presence of THC. I also located inside the bookbag, (2) clear plastic baggies with suspect cocaine residue inside, which I tested utilizing a NIK Cocaine wipe which yielded a positive result for the presence of Cocaine salts. Also inside the black bag was a AWS scale and French White Cigarette Papers which are commonly used Drug Paraphernalia (Marijuana). All paraphernalia and drugs were confiscated and later submitted into evidence.


The vehicle was towed by Beck's Towing and all (3) subjects were processed at BBPD Headquarters. I read Mollenkopf her Miranda rights with my department issued Miranda card and Mollenkopf advised that the black bag and the items inside belonged to her. Baehr and Claudio were processed and released with an NTA. Mollenkopf was charged with Possession of drug paraphernalia (F.S.S. 893.147.1), and Possession of Schedule 1 Controlled Substance (THC) (F.S.S. 893.136.A).
