PROBABLE CAUSE

On the above date and time I was working in Palm Beach County. I was traveling southbound on Interstate 95 just North of Gateway Blvd in the center lane when I observed a white in color vehicle in the inside center lane traveling at a high rate of speed. I visually estimated that vehicles speed to be approximately 95 miles per hour I also observed the vehicle to be straddling the double white lines that separate the inside lane (HOV) from the inside center lane. I then began to pace the vehicle in my marked patrol unit FHP0997. As I was pacing I observed the vehicle to continue to swerve between lanes going from the inside center lane to the outside lane (See video). I paced the vehicle for approximately a 1/4 mile and within the time the vehicle had a continuous speed of 91 miles per hour in a posted 65. I then activated my lights and sirens (emergency equipment). The vehicle continued to travel until exiting onto the Gateway Blvd exit ramp. It was not until I drove next to the vehicle and advised the driver to pull over that he did. The vehicle stopped on the right shoulder on Interstate 95 southbound exit ramp to Gateway Blvd. I then advised dispatch of my location and the stop. I then approached the vehicle from the driver's side. Upon approach I observed a white male in the driver seat. As the driver rolled down his window I observed him to have blood shot glossy eyes. I then advised the driver who I was and reason for the stop. I then asked the driver where he was coming from and once he replied I observed an odor commonly associated with that of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath as well as a slurred speech. The subject advised he was coming from "Roosters a bar in West Palm". I then asked the subject if he had been drinking to which he replied "a couple drinks". I then asked the subject if he could provide me with his driver's license at which point I was able to identify him as Randall Bourquin by his Florida driver's license. I then asked the subject if he would exit his vehicle at which he did. Upon exiting I observed the driver to have a lack of balance. I advised the driver that due to the odor I observed that I believed he was operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol and or a controlled substance and if he would perform field sobriety exercises to which he replied "yes".

Before the exercises the subject was asked if he had any medical conditions that would prevent him from performing these exercise to which he replied "no". Each exercise was demonstrated by myself and explained to the subject before he performed and each time he was asked if he understood the instructions to which he replied "yes".

After finishing the field sobriety exercises I advised the subject as well at dispatch at 2:23 am that he was being placed under arrest pursuant to F.S 316.193 suspicion of operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol and or a controlled substance. I then advised dispatch that I was on my way to the Palm Beach County Jail. Trooper Maia#1634 as well as Trooper Pajon-Zuniga stayed with the vehicle until D&D Towing took possession. Once we arrived at the

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jail I observed the subject for twenty minutes before entering into the breathalyzer room. Once inside the subject agreed to provide us two samples of his breath. At 3:10am the subject blew a .224 and then at 3:13 am he blew a .219. 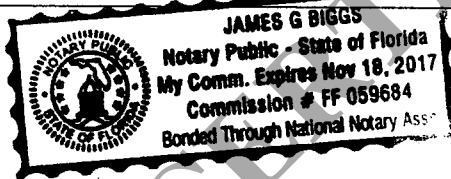
