DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On Wednesday, September 20, 2017 at approximately 2218 hours, I responded to Southern Boulevard (Bv), west of Royal Palm Beach Bv, Royal Palm Beach (Palm Beach County) Florida to assist Deputy Brian Randall with a vehicle he stopped that was driving on two flat tires. Upon my arrival I saw D/S Randall's patrol car stopped in the eastbound outside lane on Southern Bv behind a silver utility vehicle with his emergency lights activated. Other deputies were on scene as back up officers. I made contact with D/S Randall who told me the following regarding this incident: On the above date and time while on patrol traveling Eastbound on Southern Blvd approaching Royal Palm Beach Blvd, I observed a silver Chevy Tahoe bearing Florida tag #HSPW72 traveling in front of my marked patrol vehicle in the right travel lane of Southern Blvd with two flat tires on the right side of his vehicle. I activated my rear emergency lights for safety concerns so that the occupants inside the vehicle did not get rear ended. The vehicle came to a complete stop in the eastbound lanes just west of Royal Palm Beach Blvd. I exited my vehicle and made contact with the driver who was later identified by his Florida driver's license as Randy Salazar.

I initially asked Randy did he need assistance due to his vehicle having "two" flat tires on the right side of the vehicle. Randy informed me that he had struck a nail while coming back from fishing which caused the tires to go flat. While standing next to the vehicle the tires on the passenger side were completely destroyed and both rims were on the pavement. Randy exited his vehicle as I exited mine. He appeared to be uneasy on his feet and stumbled to regain his balance several times. His eyes appeared to be very red and glassy. I asked Randy if he had any drinks tonight and he stated that he did not. Due to the behavior Randy was displaying along with him driving on two flat tires I requested the assistance of a DUI investigator to respond to the scene. DUI Investigator White #7709 responded to the scene to perform several field sobriety exercises to check the welfare of Randy. It should be noted once the DUI investigator arrived on scene, I could smell an odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from Randy as he was speaking to Investigator White. This concludes my direct involvement with this case: D/S Randall wrote a sworn witness statement on a probable cause affidavit with information regarding this incident.

Prior to speaking with the driver I looked at the left front and rear tires on the utility vehicle. The tires were ruptured on the outside sidewall. I could see the rim through the tire opening. Since both tires displayed identical damage to their sidewalls suggests they struck an object as the vehicle left the roadway.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I made contact with the driver who was sitting in the driver seat of a silver utility vehicle. He was later identified as Randy William Salazar by his Florida driver license. A small child was sitting in the second row of the vehicle on the passenger side. During my interview I noticed his eyes were red, watery and glossy. His speech was slurred and his mouth was dry. He explained he was returning home from Loxahatchee where he had been fishing. His movements were lethargic. I could smell an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from the inside of the vehicle. I explained to the driver that D/S Randall observed him driving on two flat tires. After making contact with him, he had a suspicion that he may have consumed an unknown amount of alcoholic beverages. After speaking with him I also told him I had a suspicion she had been drinking an unspecified amount of unknown alcoholic beverages. He became agitated and aggressive and told me he was not saying anything until he spoke with his lawyer. I explained to him that I was actively investigating a crime of DUI where his lawyer could not interfere with my investigation. I asked him to exit his vehicle. He exited it and began leaning against it to support himself. He wore blue pants, a blue work shirt and no shoes. I asked if he would consent to performing Standardized Field Sobriety Evaluations (SFSTs) for the purpose of determining if he was impaired while operating a motor vehicle. The defendant refused, so I gave the Taylor Warnings and explained the evidence that I already had against him (all the previously mentioned indicators) would be strong basis for him being placed under arrested. Additionally I explained to him his driver license if a privilege and not a right. His signature on his license constitute consent to any sobriety test required by law during the operation of a motor vehicle. He continued to refuse; he later walked to the passenger side of his vehicle to get a nail that he alleged was inside one of his tires. As he walked I saw where he had difficulty in maintaining his balance. He stumbled and swayed on occasion. When he stood he was unsteady. I could now smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his breath which intensified when he spoke. We made contact with his wife who arrived shortly thereafter. She was allowed to take custody of their son and his personal effects. Afterward and based on D/S Randall's observation of the defendant traveling on two ruptured tires and my observation of personal indicators of impairment exhibited by him, probable cause was established for DUI. I told the driver he was being placed under lawful arrest for DUI. D/S Randall handcuffed him making certain that the cuffs were double locked and checked for proper fit prior to placing him into the rear of my patrol car.




