On the above date at approximately 0215 hours, I was on routine patrol in the area of Indiancreek Parkway and South Pennock Lane in the Town of Jupiter, Palm Beach County, Florida. I was in an unmarked patrol vehicle. That vehicle is equipped with a full emergency light and patrol siren package. I was traveling east. This is a posted 45 mile per hour zone in both directions. I observed a vehicle, later identified as a 2011 Toyota bearing Florida license plate GJFL41, coming westbound towards me. I visually estimated the vehicle's speed at 60 miles per hour. I activated my in car radar (Stalker Dual SL s/n DD005051) in opposite direction moving mode. I saw the patrol speed matched my vehicle's certified speedometer. The target speed indicated a speed of 59 then 60 miles per hour. I heard a clear audio Doppler tone. I made a u-turn and started to try to catch up to the vehicle. The vehicle turned south off the Indiancreek Parkway roundabout and then quickly turned left (east) on Canterbury Place. As I approached the southbound lanes of South Central Boulevard, I activated my vehicle's lights and sirens. The Toyota ran the stop sign and turned north at Canterbury Place and Ashford Avenue. The vehicle then drove to Bandon Lane and turned east before turning right at Edenberry Avenue and finally coming to a stop. The vehicle was fleeing from me for approximately 40 seconds before stopping. I drew my departmentally approved side arm and pointed it at the vehicle, gaining control of both occupants while I awaited back up. Upon the arrival of other officers, we conducted a felony stop and handcuffed both occupants. The driver was identified to me Robert Robison. Once I gained control of the situation, I walked up to Robison, who was in handcuffs. I read Robison his Miranda Rights from a prepared text. Robison stated he understood them. Post Miranda, Robison asserted he stopped as soon as he saw me. Robison stated he'd had, "enough" when I asked him how much he'd had to drink.

Robison stated on an impairment scale of 1-10 he was a, "4." When I asked for clarification Robison stated he'd had three to four beers then one more. I noticed Robison was slurring his speech. Robison used some unusual verbal conventions. Robison's eyes were bloodshot and glassy and I could smell the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on his breath. A few moments later I set up an area nearby to conduct roadside tasks. Officer McGillicuddy told me Robison had invoked his Miranda Rights in the meantime. I later found the specific language Robison used may not have constituted an unequivocal invocation but had treated the statement as such at the time. Robison agreed to complete the tasks. Robison indicated he did not have any medical conditions other than a recently broken fist that prevents him from making a fist or pointing effectively. I first conducted the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus task. I am a certified Drug Recognition Expert and conducted the task in a manner consistent with my training. I observed all six standardized clues of Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. Robison had Lack of Smooth Pursuit, Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation, and Onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 Degrees in both of Robison's eyes. I then conducted the Walk and Turn task. Robison lost his balance from the starting position. Robison started the task early. Robison stopped after the ninth step and asked if he should turn. Robison turned incorrectly. Robison missed heel to toe on the second step on the return leg. I next conducted the One Leg Stand task. Robison was swaying visibly during the task and miscounted several times. I next conducted the Romberg / Alphabet Task. Robison stated the alphabet as follows: A B C D E F G H I K L M N O P Q R S T U V W X Y M Z. At that time I placed Robison under arrest. I advised him and secured him in handcuffs which I double locked and checked for spacing. I transported Robison to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing Facility. Upon arrival, I provided Robison with some water to wash some leftover chewing tobacco in his mouth. I then started the 20 minute observation period. I physically turned my chair so I could face Robison during that time. I then requested Robison provide a sample of his breath. Robison said, "yes sir." Robison subsequently provided samples of .173 and .163. I then secured Robison in a holding cell while I completed my paperwork. I then booked Robison into the Palm Beach County Jail where I charged him with DUI (enhanced over .15) per FSS 316.193(4) and Fleeing / Attempting to Elude 316.1935(1).
