
(PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT)

Narrative: 2017-21840

On October 2, 2017, Palm Springs Police Department was contacted by the Department of Family and Children in reference to allegations of child abuse. The DCF Child Protection Investigator Shannon McCourt and Police Officer Frank Ricciardi responded to [REDACTED] to investigate the following allegations. The child [REDACTED] was reported that to be handcuffed to a large dog crate for extended periods of time. The child was denied food when hungry and the use of the restroom. The report indicated that [REDACTED] do this to the child. [REDACTED] has prior DCF history extending back to 2013 for other allegations of child abuse. Officer Ricciardi reported that upon his arrival at the above location he met with [REDACTED] who was outside the residence with [REDACTED] then gave him and DCF permission to speak to the child about the reported allegations. Ms. McCourt conducted a fact finding interview of the child at scene. The child stated that as discipline [REDACTED] lock him in the dog crate inside the residence. The child stated that on the day before on 10/01/17 that [REDACTED] handcuffed him to the dog crate for over 12 hours, because he went in the refrigerator without permission and drank some coffee creamer. The child stated that he is not allowed in the refrigerator without asking for permission first. The child reported that when he is handcuffed to the dog crate he is denied food and can't use the restroom. The child also reported that [REDACTED] hit him with a "vacuum stick" and have punched him before.

Ms. McCourt and Officer Ricciardi then spoke with [REDACTED] who denied handcuffing or striking the child. [REDACTED] stated that for discipline she makes [REDACTED] do yard work. [REDACTED] stated that taking things away from him or putting him in his room does not work with him. [REDACTED] spoke poorly of the child. She stated that the child is sick and delusional and his behavior sucks. During the home visit DCF asked for permission to inspect the home for the safety of the child. Officer Ricciardi documented that he observed in one of the bedrooms a large dog crate with two sets of handcuffs attached to the front of the cage. When questioned about the handcuffs [REDACTED] stated that she and [REDACTED] Robert role play. Ms. McCourt asked [REDACTED] to see the refrigerator and she noticed a glass jar containing what appeared to have marijuana inside. When Officer Ricciardi questioned [REDACTED] about the marijuana she stated it was not hers, but it belongs to a friend of [REDACTED] voluntarily turned the suspected marijuana over to Officer Ricciardi. Officer Ricciardi reported that he took photos of the dog crate and handcuffs at the scene. Officer Ricciardi reported that at the time of the initial investigation [REDACTED] was not home and he was unable to speak to him. I later spoke to Officer Ricciardi who told

me that it was a metal frame large animal cage that measured approximately 5'W x 5'L x 6'H with two sets of handcuffs attached. Officer Ricciardi reported the above cage was kept in the spare bedroom located next to the child's room. On December 27, 2017, I reviewed the Child Protection Team case summary report with the following findings. On October 03, 2017, CPT conducted a forensic interview and a medical evaluation of the child [REDACTED]. During the forensic interview the child remained very consistent with the original detailed allegations of abuse. The child stated that [REDACTED] also hit him with a stick and punched him on his back. CPT stated that the pattern type injury on the child's back is consistent with the history of being punched there, and some of the hand injuries the child had - photographed by DCF are consistent with the photographed "cage" and handcuffs restraint. The CPT medical report stated positive findings for Psychological Abuse/Neglect: The child credible history of being locked up in the "cage" handcuffed, constitute bizarre "punishment" practice accompanied by bizarre rituals that [REDACTED] imposed with respect to food and use of the bathroom.

During my investigation I researched the following reports with allegations of child abuse involving [REDACTED]

Case # 2012-05371 The allegations were the child had a cut on his right cheek of his face under his right eye due to [REDACTED] hitting him with the laundry basket. After [REDACTED] hit the child in the face, [REDACTED] then picked up the same basket and hit the child on his back even harder.


Police interview [REDACTED] and they stated that the child was very active and played sports. [REDACTED] stated the child plays rough but they did not know how the facial injury happened.

Case # 2013-8471 The allegations were [REDACTED] used a machete to discipline the child. As a result the child sustained bruises on both arms and a small cut. The child told police that [REDACTED] told him to do his homework and he told him "no" and the [REDACTED] hit him with a machete. [REDACTED] told police [REDACTED] in fact hit the child couple of time with the empty nylon machete case, which was soft. Police was unable to interview [REDACTED] at the time.

On January 8, 2018, at approximately 1730 hours, Robert Dersa II came to the police department following our request for him to come for an interview in reference to the above allegations. During the interview Mr. Dersa stated that he thought that it was all over since he gave the State of Florida [REDACTED] that was out of control. Dersa stated that [REDACTED] has mental problems and has been out of control for couple of years in which he had attended [REDACTED] and it did not work out. Mr. Dersa upon being question became upset and angry towards [REDACTED] telling me that he was happy that the state took [REDACTED] who is a mental case. Mr. Dersa denied ever putting [REDACTED] in the large metal dog crate or handcuffing the child. When asked the reason he purchase the large cage he told me it was for two large Iguanas. He then attempted to find in his phone the photos of the iguanas with negative result. Mr. Dersa told me that he purchased the cage from TSC distributor and it measures 5x9x6 and it takes almost the spare room. Mr. Dersa stated that for the last eleven and a half years [REDACTED] has been nothing but a problem for him and [REDACTED]. Based on the above investigation I find probable cause to arrest Robert Dersa II for Child Abuse and Aggravated Child Abuse.


