NARRATIVE:

On Friday, August 10th, 2018 at approximately 2332 hrs while in the area of 45th Street and Australian Avenue, in unincorporated Mangonia Park, Palm Beach County, Florida, 33401 I observed a black BMW 2DR bearing Florida License Plate IMXZ68 stopped at the intersection in the west bound center number 2 lane of travel.

I observed the traffic signal turn green and proceeded through the intersection in the west bound number 1 lane of travel as I did I heard vehicles behind me in the center number 2 lane of travel begin honking their horns. I noted that the black BMW had not moved I observed the traffic signal turn back to red. At this time I turned around and proceeded back to the intersection as I approached the intersection I again observed west bound traffic get a green traffic signal. I observed traffic in the outside number 1 and number 3 lanes of travel proceed through the intersection. I noted that traffic in the center number 2 lane of travel did not move and vehicles behind the BMW again began honking their horns.

Upon turning around and proceeding to get behind the BMW I observed the driver in the vehicle with her head slumped down to her chest. As I got behind the vehicle a white chevy malibu got between us at the intersection as the traffic signal again cycled to green, the BMW still did not move, I observed the white malibu veer around the BMW and proceeded through the intersection.


At this time I activated my over head lights and advised communications that I was out with a possible ill person passed out behind the wheel of the vehicle. I requested EMS

as I proceeded to the driver's side of the BMW. Upon approaching the driver's window I observed the driver a white female passed out head down to her chest with the window up, the vehicle on and running and in drive. I noted the windows were frosted over.

At this time I tapped the window and driver slowly began moving lifting her head and then looked at me. I signaled for her to put the window down which she did slowly. I asked the driver to put her vehicle in park which she did slowly, I then asked her to turn the vehicle off. As I spoke to the driver I noted a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from her head and shoulder area even before she began speaking. I asked the driver if she had any medical problems to which she stated "yes my lawyer."

I then requested the drivers license which she provided I noted that her photograph was affixed and identified her as Robyn Louise Griffith Barrera. At this time based on my observations, I made contact with Investigator K. White I.D. 7209 of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office VCD/DUI Unit who responded to the scene and conducted a DUI Investigation.

I made contact with the driver who was currently sitting in the driver seat of the previously mentioned vehicle. She was later identified as Robyn Louise Griffith Barrera by her Florida driver license. She made an utterance of "I fucked up, I am intoxicated". Her eyes were red, watery and glossy. Her cheeks were flushed and mouth was dry. Her speech was slurred and she was upset. I could smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from the inside of the vehicle. I told her I had a suspicion that she had been drinking an unspecified amount of alcoholic beverages. She nodded her head in approval. She asked that I call her ex husband who was retired from the sheriff's office. I explained that I was investigating her for suspicion of DUI. I asked if she had any physical problems with her body that would inhibit her from performing light physical movements. I also asked if she was taking medication. She ultimately advised she was not taking medication. We blocked the left turn lane and I escorted her into the parking lot of a convenient store. During the escort I noticed she labored in maintaining her balance. She was unsteady while walking and swayed while standing. I allowed her to use the restroom before asking if she would consent to performing Standardized Field Sobriety Evaluations (SFSTs) for the purpose of determining if she was impaired while operating a motor vehicle. She refused to perform the SFSTs. She began crying as I explained the Taylor Warnings that informed performing the SFSTs were voluntary and she did not have to comply. However if she did not comply I would only be left with the evidence before me (previously mentioned indicators) which could be strong basis of her being placed under arrest for DUI. Afterward I asked if she understood the warnings. She acknowledged the warnings but refused to cooperate. I could now smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her breath that intensified when she spoke. Since she refused to perform the SFSTs, and based on D/S Blackman's of the defendant being in actual physical control of her vehicle through the cycling of the traffic light without any response, coupled with my observation of personal indicators of impairment exhibited by the defendant, probable cause was established for DUI. I told the defendant she was being placed under lawful arrest for DUI. She was searched by a City of West Palm Beach police officer. I placed her in handcuffs, double locked and checked for proper fit, prior to seating her in the rear of my patrol car. Priority Towing responded on a two rotation request to impound the defendant's vehicle to their lot. Meanwhile I began transport to the main jail breath analysis facility for further processing. Upon our arrival I escorted her into the facility and began a 20 minute observation period. During this time she ingested nothing into her body orally or otherwise. She also did not regurgitate. Afterward I escorted her into the testing room and asked her to provide breath samples. She refused. I read implied consent in its entirety and asked if she understood afterward. She told me she did understand. I asked if she would reconsider her refusal and give the breath samples. She once again refused. At this time she was deemed a "refusal". I attempted to advise her of her Constitutional Rights. She interrupted through this process. She later said she did not want to be interviewed. The defendant was issued a DUI citation and booked into the main jail without incident.

On Friday, August 10, 2018 at approximately 2337 hours, I responded to the intersection of 45th Street and Australian Avenue, in the City of Mangonia Park (Palm Beach County) Florida to assist Deputy Victor Blackman with a motorist who was passed out in the driver seat of her vehicle. While en route to this location Fire Rescue was notified to respond for medical assessment. They were canceled prior to my arrival. Upon my arrival I noticed D/S Blackman's patrol car stopped in the westbound outside through lanes on 45th St with his emergency lights activated. Two district 2 cars were also on scene as back up officers. I saw a black BMW stopped in front of D/S Blackman's patrol car facing west. I made contact with D/S Blackman who told me as he proceeded west on 45th St. through the intersection of Australian Ave he heard vehicles honking their horns at a stopped vehicle. He turned around and watched the traffic signal cycle green. He noticed vehicles behind a black BMW honking their horns in an attempt to gain the attention of the driver of the BMW. He watched a vehicle veer around the BMW before he got behind it. D/S Blackman activated his emergency lights and notified dispatch of him being out with a subject passed in the driver seat. He tapped on the window and the driver responded by lifting her head and turning toward him. He signaled for her to lower her window. She complied slowly. He asked her to shut her vehicle off. D/S Blackman detected an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from the inside of the vehicle. He also suspected the driver to be impaired. He asked that a DUI unit respond to his location to investigate the driver for DUL.


