 On the 27 day of April, 2019 at 00:32 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On April 27, 2019, at approximately 0032 hours, I was dispatched to 1416 W Hardee St, in reference to an accident, "vehicle versus pedestrian."

I arrived and observed a white female in the grass on the east side of S 14th St at the intersection of W Hardee St laying on her stomach. Upon checking on the female I observed blood coming from her head and she had road rash on her right shoulder and back area. I also observed a blood trail in the roadway stretching, from the front of 1416 W Hardee St to where the victim was found. The total length of the blood trail left by the victim was 207 feet (measured using a speed laser). The apparent blood trail was lead down the middle of the street.

It should be noted that W Hardee Street is a two-lane road with no dividing lines. W Hardee Street is a one-block long and dead-ends to the west at I95. Traveling east from the point of impact, W Hardee Street intersects (T-intersection) with S 14th Street. S 14th St is also a two-lane residential road which is divided by a double yellow line.

Upon speaking to the female she was able to verbally identify herself as Kristin Stanley-Motzner (dob 07/11/77). The victim informed me that while on foot she was struck by a black American made pickup truck which was backing up. The victim also advised me that she was able to get the first three of the license plate "IH3" which she had written on a receipt. The victim turned the receipt over to me which I later placed into evidence.







Palm Beach County Fire Rescue 37 (RUN#1945632) arrived on scene and began to render aid to the victim. I was informed that due to the extent of the victim injuries she was being listed a trauma and would be transported to Delray Medical Center by ground. While the victim was being treated by Palm Beach County Fire Rescue I took 19 digital







<p>photographs of the victim's injuries and the scene which I later placed into evidence.</p> <p>There were two witnesses, Thomas Bruce (dob 04/09/1993) and James Todd (dob 01/07/1992) both reside at 1416 W Hardee Street. They advised that they were both in the front of their house sitting on a bench smoking with a clear view of the roadway. They both informed me of the following information:</p> <p>They advised that they observed a female get hit by a black pickup truck, possibly a GMC or a Chevy. They stated that the female ended up under the truck and the driver was backing his truck up while dragging the female. The female was dragged for approximately 100 feet where she came to final rest in the grass. They then advised me that the truck took off heading north on S 14th St.</p> <p>I met with a neighbor Lillian Bossler located at 1403 W Hardee St, (two houses east, on the north side of the road from where the crash occurred) who informed me that she captured the incident on her CCTV cameras. I briefly reviewed the footage which shows the victim behind the pickup truck. The driver then backs up eastbound slowly dragging the victim underneath the truck and dragging her to the end (east side) of S 14th St. The truck then drives forward leaving the scene leaving the victim on the side of the road. The truck is last seen heading northbound on S 14th St.</p> <p>It should be noted that the Lantana Police Department received a 911 call at approximately 0055 hours, (approximately 23 minutes later) from the residence of 1123 S 14th Pl. This address is just two blocks north of the crash scene. The caller advised that there was to an unknown black truck that was parked in their yard. They further advised that they did not believe anyone was inside the truck. Upon clearing the accident scene I responded to the above-noted address. Upon my arrival, at approximately 0122 hours, Sgt. Oquist and I observed a black pickup truck matching the description given by the victim. The truck was parked partially in the front yard of 1123 S 14th Pl. The first three of the tag matched what the victim provided. While walking around the truck we observed a white male laying on the ground approximately 10 to 15 feet from the open driver's side door. The male had glassy eyes and smelled of an unknown alcoholic beverage and once on his feet, he could hardly stand. He appeared to be highly intoxicated to me. While speaking to the male subject he did not verbally answer any of my questions. I was finally able to identify the male subject by his Florida Driver's License as Ryan McDowell (dob 02/04/84) the owner of the black pickup truck. McDowell was the only subject located near the vehicle. It should be noted that Palm Beach County Fire Rescue also responded to my location to check on the subject we were out with. Sgt. Oquist advised that while conducting a pat-down search of Mc Dowell for officer safety (due to a gun found in the vehicle which was in plain view in the front driver's side door) he located a set of keys in belonging to the truck in his right front pocket.</p> <p>Based on the extent of injury to Kristin and the vehicle the description of the suspect</p>

<p>vehicle it was determined that McDowell's pickup truck would be seized and brought to the Lantana Police in an attempt to locate any evidence. I then asked McDowell accompany back to the Lantana Police Department. He was transported in my marked police vehicle due to his vehicle being towed Joy's Towing and the fact that he was plainly too intoxicated to drive or to be left abandoned on the side of the road. At this point in time, McDowell was not placed under arrest or handcuffed during the transport. It should be noted that at no time during the initial contact or during the transport McDowell never asked me what had happened or what he had done. Upon later review of my in-car video, McDowell was observed crying almost immediately upon entry and then sleeping in the back of my marked patrol vehicle. Upon arrival at the Lantana Police Department, I brought McDowell to the interview room. I then read McDowell his Miranda warnings and began a taped interview. McDowell informed me of the following information:</p> <p>He drove his black GMC pickup truck to the Old Key Lime House where he drank alcohol until he could not remember anything after that.</p> <p>McDowell advised that he could not remember leaving the bar. Upon the completion of the interview, McDowell was picked up by a family member.</p> <p>Subsequent follow-up investigation on May 1, 2019, I responded to 1123 14th Place, Lantana, FL 33462, to meet with the residents. I met with Hector Navarro (dob 10/12/77) and Lady Ortiz (dob 07/19/79) who observed a black truck in their yard. Ortiz informed me she is the one that called 911 and informed me of the following information: Ortiz stated that she was inside her bedroom (northwest side) when she saw lights from a vehicle from outside (southeast side) of her house shining inside the window. She then peered through the front window and observed a black pickup truck with the dome light on. She advised that she could not see anyone inside the truck, but observed the driver's side door was open.</p> <p>Ortiz thought it was maybe one of her son's friend coming over to visit. Ortiz checked with her son, who advised that he did not recognize the vehicle. Ortiz advised that when she went back to the window, she observed a male subject lying on the grass near the street.</p> <p>On May 1, 2019, I went to Memorial Regional Hospital located at 3501 Johnson St, Hollywood, FL 33021, to follow up with the victim. Upon arrival, I went to the Emergency ICU (room 202-6) where I met with the victim and conducted an audio-recorded interview. During the interview the victim informed me of the following information: The victim stated that she just got home from work (Bonefish Grill restaurant where she works as a server located at Congress Ave and Gateway Blvd) at approximately 0000 hours. While she was inside her residence (1410 W Hardee St), she heard a loud "vroom" and screeching tires" from a vehicle and was concerned that her dog was outside and possibly in danger. The victim stated that she went outside to locate her dog and saw a black pickup truck stopped at the dead-end of her street with its interior lights on. The truck then started backing up at an estimated speed of 25 MPH. The vehicle began</p>

The victim saw the driver and only occupant through the back window, describing him as a white male, with a short haircut, a heavy "five o'clock shadow", 25-35 years of age, medium build, and dark-colored eyes. The victim went to get the license plate from the truck writing it on a restaurant receipt the victim believed was from the "Key Lime Pie" "Lantana" she had found on the ground. It should be noted there is a restaurant in Lantana named the Old Key Lime House located at 300 E Ocean Ave. The victim was able to obtain the first three letters of the license plate (IH3) on the receipt. She did this because she thought the driver of the truck may have been drunk. She described the vehicle as a newer black American made truck and believed the truck was a Silverado. The victim stated that the vehicle had stopped and she slapped the back of the truck and screamed: "Stop!" The victim stated that the driver saw her as he was looking at her through the back window. The driver pulled forward and the victim thought the driver was allowing her to cross to go back to her house. She advised the vehicle then began backing up slamming into her as she repeatedly yelled: "Stop." The victim stated that she was dragged for approximately 150 yards while she was stuck underneath the truck.</p> <p>The victim reported that she suffered three broken bones to her back, a broken pelvis on both sides, surgery to put screws in both hips, fractures to both of her feet which will require surgery to fix. The victim informed me that Memorial Regional Hospital took photographs of her injuries (road rash) when she arrived. The victim gave me permission to recover the photographs from the hospital. I received five photographs of the injuries which were located on her right shoulder, back, right thigh, hip, and another side of the back, which appear to show heavy/ "road rash" injuries. These photographs were placed into evidence at the Lantana Police Department.</p> <p>On May 2, 2019, I met with the management of the Old Key Lime House (a restaurant and bar) located at 300 E Ocean Ave, which is approximately two miles away from the scene and was able to conduct a search of receipts by customer name. I learned that there was a bar receipt for customer "Ryan McDowell" the night of 4/26/2019 and morning of 4/27/2019. Sgt. Schaaf and I then watched approximately 2.5 hours of high-quality surveillance video from inside the business. Comparing the receipt drink orders, and watching the drinks being made, from watching the video and later learned:</p> <p>9:52 PM - McDowell orders, receives and later consumes a double Captain Morgan rum and Pepsi cocktail, prepared and served by Bartender Phelps;</p> <p>10:11 PM - McDowell orders, receives and later consumes a double Captain Morgan rum and Pepsi cocktail, prepared and served by Bartender Phelps;</p> <p>10:37 PM - McDowell orders, receives and later consumes a double Captain Morgan rum and Pepsi cocktail, prepared and served by Bartender Douglas;</p> <p>11:10 PM - McDowell orders, receives and later consumes a double Captain Morgan rum and Pepsi cocktail, prepared and served by Bartender Douglas;</p> <p>11:33 PM - McDowell orders, receives and later consumes a double Captain Morgan rum and Pepsi cocktail, prepared and served by Bartender Phelps;</p>

<p>12:06 AM - McDowell does a shot of what appears to be a shot of Crown Royal Whiskey, prepared and served by Bartender Phelps; but placed on another patron's tab.</p> <p>12:10 AM - McDowell orders, receives, and later consumes a double Captain Morgan rum and Pepsi cocktail, served by Bartender Phelps (note the receipt indicates a single Captain Morgan rum and Pepsi cocktail but from the video, the cocktail appears to be another double pour).</p> <p>12:23 AM - McDowell leaves the bar alone and is last seen walking alone eastbound on East Ocean Ave (out of camera view).</p> <p>12: 25 AM - A black truck resembling McDowell's vehicle is seen driving westbound on East Ocean Ave. It should be noted that when McDowell was leaving the bar he had trouble maintaining his balance and his right side of his body hit the side of a chair and table.</p> <p>On May 7, 2019, I conducted a phone interview (recorded) with witness James Todd (dob 01/07/1992) who informed me of the following information: Todd stated that he and Thomas Bruce were sitting on a patio chair outside of 1416 W Hardee St, (which is right where the accident occurred) smoking a cigarette and saw a black truck drive down the street (W Hardee) fast (approximately 40 to 50 miles per hour) and swerving "as if he was drunk." The driver of the vehicle was being loud (yelling) and belligerent inside the car and went to the end of the street (the west side which is a dead end) and was there about 30 to 45 seconds. The truck started reversing and that's when his neighbor (the victim) was outside and yelling at the driver inside the truck to stop. The victim then said "what are you doing, what are you doing" and then the victim yells to him calls the cops and then the victim gets ran over by the driver. Todd describes the truck like a black Chevy Silverado. Todd states that it was a male driver (from hearing his voice while he was yelling) but never got to see him.</p> <p>On May 9, 2019, at approximately 1015 hours, myself and Detective Dipolito went to Hollywood Regional Hospital 6th floor N section to meet with Kristin so Detective Dipolito can conduct a photo lineup. It should be noted that Detective Dipolito was unaware of the suspect or the suspect's location in the lineup. I stepped out of the room so Detective Dipolito could conduct the photo line-up. When Detective Dipolito was finished with the photo line-up he informed me of the following information: The victim looked at the lineup and informed Detective Dipolito that the subject in position 2 which is the suspect (Upper Middle) resembled the person who hit her with his vehicle. The victim could only be 10% sure and stated that the nose was what caught her attention. The photo lineup was placed into evidence at the Lantana Police Department.</p> <p>On May 11, 2019, I went to Palm Beach County Fire Rescue (station 37) and met with Captain Michael Politi who was on scene in reference to case # 19-001039. I asked Captain Politi the following questions:</p>

<p>I asked Captain Politi what he was dispatched to? Captain Politi replied he was initially dispatched to a female that was struck by a vehicle. After treatment of the female, who was transported to the hospital as a trauma he was dispatched to a male subject on the ground in the yard and the residents did not know if he was ok.</p> <p>I asked Captain Politi where was the male subject located? He replied sitting near the truck (maybe 10 feet away from the driver's side door). The male subject was sitting, would not speak with Palm Beach County Fire Rescue. The male subject nodded yes or no a couple of times to questions they were asking. Captain Politi advised he could smell the odor of alcohol coming from the subject. When the male subject did speak his only answers were yes or no.</p> <p>I asked Captain Politi how long he has been with Palm Beach County Fire Rescue? He replied he has been on the job for 23 years.</p> <p>I asked Captain Politi did the subject give any indications from your experience that would lead you to believe that he was under the influence of something? Captain Politi replied yes, just by the subject moving slow and when he stood up, he was staggering and when he nodded it was slower. Typically, people not under the influence would nod faster than the subject was nodding. Captain Politi advised that when he was asking what year it was and who is the current president. He did not answer what year it was and when he answered the question about the president, he did have slurred speech.</p> <p>I asked Captain Politi how many people he has come in contact with along that have been under the influence? He replied quite a few and based on what the subject displayed he was definitely under the influence of something.</p> <p>I asked Captain Politi when you deal with drunk people do they typically not speak with you? He replied usually the ones that do not want to get in trouble, also if they do not speak they do not want to get in trouble and they do not want to incriminate themselves.</p> <p>I asked Captain Politi do you remember seeing the subject's vehicle at any time? He replied he saw it in the yard. I asked how was the vehicle positioned? He replied not knowing what he was doing when he pulled into the yard. Captain Politi remembers asking him if he knew who's yard he pulled into and he shook his head no. Captain Politi asked the subject if he knew where he was and the subject shook his head no. This ended my contact with Captain Politi.</p> <p>On May 17, 2019, I received the keys to the 2014 black GMC to complete my search warrant. While I was checking the inside of the vehicle I observed the backup camera which was fully functional. Also, it should be noted that the high beams were on and the windshield wipers also on (it was not raining that night). I was able to DNA swab several areas from the rear and undercarriage of the truck. The DNA analysis is pending to see if the victim's DNA is on the vehicle.</p> <p>In summation: On April 26, 2019, at approximately 2152 hours, McDowell was at the Old Key Lime House and ordered his first drink. McDowell orders his last drink on April 27, 2019, at 0010 hours. In the two hours and thirty-one minutes McDowell was at the</p>

On April 27, 2019, at 0023 hours, McDowell is observed leaving the bar alone and is last seen walking eastbound on East Ocean Ave (out of camera view). At 0025 hours, a black truck resembling McDowell's vehicle is seen driving westbound on East Ocean Ave into and out of the camera's view.</p> <p>A review of video from 1403 W Hardee St, shows the suspect pickup truck traveling north at a high rate of speed on S 14th St at 2357 hours and 40 seconds (camera 03) compared to the other vehicles traveling on the same street. It should be noted that the time stamp from the cameras is not the correct time. The suspect pickup truck enters W Hardee St, at 2357 hours and 41 seconds. The vehicle is out of camera view for approximately three minutes. While reviewing camera 06 with a timestamp of 0000 hrs and 57 seconds the victim can be seen being dragged under the pickup trucks passenger rear as it was backing up. The victim is dragged into the view of camera 03 where she is finally released from under the pickup truck at 0001 hours and 40 seconds where the pickup truck is seen fleeing northbound. The victim was struck and dragged under the pickup truck for a total of 43 seconds. The victim sustained great bodily injury from this incident and was transported as a trauma.</p> <p>On April 27, 2019, at approximately 0032 hours, I was dispatched to 1416 W Hardee St, reference a hit and run accident, vehicle versus pedestrian. Through my investigation, it was determined that a black American made pickup truck with the first three of the tag being IH3 struck the victim and fled the scene. At approximately 0055 hours, the Lantana Police Department received a 911 call from the residence of 1123 S 14th PL. This address is just two blocks north of where the accident occurred and is right near the dead-end near I95. The caller advised that there was to an unknown black truck that was parked in their yard.</p> <p>Upon my arrival, I observed a black pick up truck with the first three of the tag matching the victim's description and a white male lying on the ground who was later identified as Ryan McDowell, the registered owner of the pickup truck. McDowell was the only person around the truck and was approximately 10-15 feet away from the open driver's side door.</p> <p>The victim, in this case, was shown a photo line up and picked Ryan McDowell (the suspect) out of a photo-line up as the person who ran her over. Based on my interviews with multiple people I believe Ryan McDowell was the person that ran over the victim.</p> <p>Based upon my investigation, the amount of drinks that the defendant consumed in a short time period, injuries to the victim and the witness statements I believe there is probable cause to charge the Defendant for driving under the influence with serious bodily injury and leaving the scene of an accident with serious bodily injury.</p>
