On the 23 day of July, 2018 at 00:53 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest)

On 7-23-2018 at 0032 hours, I was traveling northbound on N. Federal Hwy. when I observed a grey Mini Cooper vehicle stopped facing southbound on the raised concrete median in the middle of the roadway at approximately 2300 N. Federal Hwy. As I approached the vehicle, I could see a W/F sitting in the driver's seat of the car staring directly forward without acknowledging that I was there. I tried to gain her attention, but she continued to stare directly forward with a blank look. I conducted a U-Turn in the roadway to check on the welfare of the driver, but the vehicle accelerated away from me and was now traveling southbound in the northbound lanes. I was able to catch up with the vehicle in the parking of 1968 NE 5th Ave. and I conducted a traffic stop on the car. I walked to the driver's side portion of the car and made contact with the W/F, identified as Sasha Matson. Matson advised that her window was broken, and she was unable to do roll it down. I had to inform her to open her door, which she did. Upon doing so, I immediately detected the strong of an alcoholic beverage coming from her person. Upon speaking with Matson, she said that she was "sorry." I asked Matson where she was coming from and she advised that she was going to pick her up boyfriend at a local bar. I asked her if she remembered being stopped on the raise concrete median and she advised that it had been a "long day." I asked how much alcohol she had consumed, and she said that she "didn't really have any." She changed her story a few moments later and advised that she did not have any alcohol. Ofc. Clinard responded on scene as back-up.

I ran her information through FCIC/NCIC and then returned to her vehicle and asked that she exit her car, which she did. Once out of the car, I again asked Matson if she had consumed any alcohol tonight, she advised she had a "glass of prosecco" about "seven hours ago." I asked her where she consumed the wine and she said "nowhere." I asked Matson where she was coming from and she said. "I was just driving."

I then asked Matson if she knew where she was, and she said "I'm pretty sure I'm in

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Boca." Matson advised that she was close to "Palmetto Drive" or "whatever."

Based on my observations and Matson's driving pattern, I requested that she consent to the standard roadside exercises to dispel my alarm she was driving impaired, she gave consent.

Matson advised she does not have any injuries and was not taking any medications.

I explained and demonstrated each task before he attempted them.

The first task was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. While observing HGN, a lack of smooth pursuit was present in both eyes. Each eye had a constant jerking while at maximum deviation. Onset prior to 45 degrees was also present.

The second task was the Walk and Turn. She did not maintain the starting position. Matson did not go heel to toe at all during the task. She did not count her steps out loud as instructed. Matson took 19 steps forward and 13 steps back. She also used her arms for balance.

The third task was the One Leg Stand. Matson did not count out loud during the task. Matson lost her balance during the task and was hopping. She used her arms for balance.

The fourth task was the Finger to Nose (L-R-L-R-R-L). Matson could not follow the instructions. Matson missed the tip of her nose and held her finger. Matson also lifted her leg in the air during the task. Matson did the same thing during the next finger to nose sequence and could not follow instructions. After failing to perform the task correctly, Matson just stared forward and did not perform the task. We moved onto the next task.

The fifth task was the Rhomberg Alphabet. Matson advised she graduated from High School and would have no issue with the task. Matson got to the letter S and paused the task, confused as to what letter to say next. She paused for several moments and then said, "L, M, N, O, P" and then stopped the task.

At 0053 hours, I placed Matson under arrest for DUI per F.S.S. 316.193(1). I transported Matson to the Boca Raton Police Department for processing and Ofc. Reissi responded to conduct the Intoxilyzer 8000. While in the DUI room, Matson refused to provide a breath sample. I read her implied consent and again she refused.

It was later determined that Matson has a prior refusal to submit to a lawful sample of her breath and was charged per F.S.S. 316.1939(1) for the prior refusal.
