While conducting further investigation into the registered owner of the Chevy Suburban identified as Shadi Ayesh, I discovered that Ayesh currently has two felony warrants, for Possession of a Weapon by a Prohibited Person (St. Lucie County Sheriff's Office) and Violation of Community Control original offense being Felony DWLS (Indian River County Sheriff's Office). Surveillance was conducted at Ayesh's last known address located at 5911 Albert Rd unincorporated West Palm Beach, Florida. At approximately 1200hrs Ayesh was observed exiting his residence wearing a white t-shirt, white hat and blue jeans. Ayesh enters the white Chevy Suburban (Z7UW) and proceeds to drive east on Albert Rd. Moving surveillance was conducted on the vehicle until it ultimately came to a stop, parking in the parking lot of the Quickies Mini Mart (3676 Collin Dr). Ayesh is observed exiting the vehicle and entering the Mini Mart. Contact was made with Ayesh inside of the Mini Mart where he was taken into custody without incident. While standing next to the Ayesh's Chevy Suburban I detected an odor of marijuana coming from within the vehicle. In plain view located in the center console cup holder was several small pieces of a green leafy substance which through my training and experience I suspected to be raw marijuana. At 1300hrs, Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office K-9 handler Agent Blagioti # 7299 responded to the scene to conduct a narcotics detection sweep with his certified K-9 partner JOHN. While walking around the vehicle K9 JOHN gave a positive alert on the driver's side of the vehicle, indicating the presence and/or odor of narcotics.

Due to the odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle, suspected marijuana in plain located on the center console, the fact that this same vehicle was observed previously delivering the brown paper bag containing 122grams of marijuana documented under PBSO case #17-165421, coupled with K9 JOHN positive alert on the vehicle, I have reason to believe that the Suburban contains other property of evidential value to the case. On 12-20-2017 at 1625hrs a Search Warrant was drafted for the Chevrolet Suburban and granted/signed by the Honorable Judge Dana Santino.

On 12-21-2017 at 1430hrs I responded to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Impound Lot to execute the Search Warrant. Present on scene was D/S Guevara from the Dist. 1 Street Team and Agent Blaglotl from the PBSO Narcotics Unit. Upon search of the vehicle Agent Blaglotl discovered three clear plastic sandwich bags located in the center console to the vehicle containing a green leafy substance which I suspected to be raw marijuana (26grams TPW).

I was able to access the storage compartment behind the digital display located in the center console/ CD player. Inside the compartment were the following items;

- 1) (1) clear plastic sandwich bag containing (5) suspected MDMA pills (2.3grams TPW)
- 2) clear sandwich bag containing (8) smaller clear plastic jewelry bags each containing suspected to be cocaine (6.2grams TPW)
- 3) clear sandwich bags containing (20) white pills, markings: A333 (12grams TPW)
- 4) (1) loose clear plastic jewelry bag containing suspected cocaine and (1) digital scale (.5grams TPW)

Upon a search of the trunk I discovered correspondence (vehicle registration) for the Chevrolet Suburban assigned to Shadi Ayeshe and (1) black plastic magnetic box. It should be noted that this particular box is commonly used by narcotics dealers/traffickers as a means to hide illicit narcotics under a vehicle to avoid being located in the event the vehicle is searched. The undercarriage of the vehicle was searched in an attempt to locate any other similar boxes but was met with negative results. A portion of the suspected cocaine from the sandwich bags along with a portion from the individual/loose bag was tested utilizing a Cobalt test kit which yielded positive results for the presence of cocaine. A portion of the suspected marijuana was tested utilizing a Duquenois test kit which yielded positive results for the presence of THC, the active ingredient in marijuana. Poison control was contacted and the (20) white pills were identified as being Oxycodone 10mg Schedule II, reference Poison Control #J2137803. A portion of the suspected MDMA was also tested, which yielded positive results.

Due to the aforementioned I find probable cause to charge Shadi Ayeshe with Possession of Cocaine w/ Intent to Sell pursuant to FSS 893.13(1a), Possession of MDMA pursuant to FSS 893.13(6a), Possession of Marijuana over 20grams pursuant to FSS 893.13(6a) and Possession of a Schedule II substance pursuant to FSS 893.13(6A).
