D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

PERSONAL CONTACT/DRIVING PATTERN/OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

On the above date and time I responded to Renaissance Commons Dr and Park Terr in reference to a Reckless Driver. Let it be noted that this incident occurred within the City of Boynton Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida. Caller, W/M Stamatopoulos, Stamatis (06/30/69), advised Boynton Beach Communication that he was following a Gray Mazda6 bearing Florida tag DLFX03 that was traveling northbound on S. Congress Ave from Summit Dr at a high rate of speed, estimate speeds of over 60mph. Stamatopoulos advised that the Mazda was "all over the roadway" and striking the lifted center median multiple times. Stamatopoulos advised that it appeared that the driver was impaired.

As units responded to the area, K-9 Officer Adams located the Mazda at the intersection of Boynton Beach Blvd and Congress Ave and eventually conducted a traffic stop on said vehicle at the intersection of Renaissance Commons Dr and Park Terr. Upon arrival I made contact with K-9 Officer Adams who advised that upon locating the vehicle he began to follow the vehicle as it continued to travel northbound on Congress Ave. K-9 Officer Adams advised that the vehicle was failing to maintain a single lane, affecting other vehicles in the area. K-9 Officer Adams advised that while the vehicle was traveling in the inside lane, of the 3 lane roadway, and approaching the intersection of Renaissance Commons Dr the vehicle made an invasion swerve to the right. K-9 Officer Adams advised that the Mazda quickly swerved right nearly striking multiple vehicles as it made a right hand turn onto Renaissance Commons Dr from the inside lane. K-9 Officer Adams advised at that point he conducted activated his emergency lights and sirens and completed a traffic stop on said vehicle at Renaissance Commons Dr and Park Terr. K-9 Officer Adams advised that he then made contact with the driver/sole occupant of the vehicle W/M Taheri, Shawn (08/15/87); who produced his Florida Driver's License. K-9 Officer Adams advised that while making contact with Taheri he noticed that he appeared to be under the influence of some sort of a chemical and/or control substance. K-9 Officer Adams advised that Taheri speech was slow and thick and that he had a difficult time keeping his eyes opened. K-9 Officer Adams advised that Taheri appeared to be lethargic. See K-9 Officer Adams' supplement for further.

I then made contact with Taheri, who was still sitting in the driver seat of his vehicle. While quickly speaking with Taheri in reference to the reason why a traffic stop was conducted on him and requesting for his credentials, I detected all the indicators that K-9

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Officer Adams did. Therefore after properly positioning my vehicle, I requested Taheri to exit his vehicle and walk towards the front of my vehicle (4445) so that I could continue my investigation; which he agreed to. While walking towards my vehicle Taheri began to stumbled, appearing as if he was going to fall. Once in front of my vehicle I advised Taheri that the investigation was being audio and video recorded, which he stated that he understood. I then reassured again to Taheri to reason for the traffic stop, which he understood and admitted to driving reckless. When asked where he was coming from Taheri advised a restaurant in Boca Raton and that he was traveling home with the assistance of his GPS. While speaking with Taheri, his speech was still slow and thick and appeared to be lethargic. Taheri was swaying side to side and his eyes were heavy. During the investigation it appeared as if Taheri was falling asleep, which I had to advise Taheri numerous times to wake up. There was also a faint odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from Taheri's person. Based on his appearance, it was known to me that Taheri was under the influence of either an alcoholic beverage and/or a chemical and/or controlled substance. Therefore I asked Taheri if he had any type of alcoholic beverages today, which he stated yes. Taheri advised that he had some sort of a Cider 12oz beer prior to leaving his residence to Boca Raton, and while at dinner he had some sort of Thai 12oz beer. Taheri advised that he only had two beers today. I then ask Taheri if has taken any type of illegal narcotics and/or medication, he advised only Methocarbamol (muscle relaxer). Based on my investigation at this point I requested Taheri to submit to a serial of road side sobriety task, which he agreed to. Prior to starting the tasks I asked Taheri if he had any disabilities and/or injuries I should know about, which he stated yes. Taheri advised that he had a spinal fusion in 2001 that still affects him and that he has really bad tremors. See the following:

WALK AND TURN:

The task was explained and demonstrated to Taheri, which he stated that he understood. During the instructional stage, Taheri had a difficult time standing the manner I requested of him. Taheri attempted numerous time but due to that fact that I fear Taheri was going to fall I advised him to stand in a normal manner. During the walking stage, Taheri took 11 steps forward, missing heel to toe between numerous steps, stepping off the line/paused for balance numerous times. Taheri completed the turn improperly. Taheri took 11 returning steps, missing heel to toe between numerous steps, stepping off the line/ paused for balance numerous times.

ONE LEG STAND:

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The task was explained and demonstrated to Taheri, which he stated that he understood. During the instructional stage, Taheri swayed back and forth; at times appearing that he was going to fall. During the balancing stage, Taheri raised his right foot. Dropping it on count number 5,6,8,12,20. Taheri used his arms for balance.

FINGER TO NOSE:

The task was explained and demonstrated to Taheri, which he stated that he understood. During the instructional stage, Taheri swayed back and forth. During the exercise stage Taheri missed his nose on the last Right Hand command.

ROMBERG/ALPHABET:

The task was explained and demonstrated to Taheri, which he stated that he understood. During the instructional stage, Taheri swayed back and forth. During the exercise stage Taheri had no indicators.

Based on the above facts, Taheri was placed into custody under suspicion of DUI, placed into handcuff (D/L and Spaced). While search incident to arrest, Taheri advised that he had 3 caps of Heroin in his pocket. A search of his front right pocket revealed 2 empty and 1 partially full capsule containing an off-white powdery substance, based on my training and experience it is known to me as Heroin, in a 1x1 clear plastic baggie. A loose empty capsule containing the same substance was located in his front right pocket as well. The suspect Heroin was later field tested, revealing to be positive for Heroin. Upon discovering the Heroin I asked Taheri if he taken the Heroin today which he stated yes. Taheri advised that he had taken the Heroin prior to going to Boca Raton at approximately 1800hrs.

Taheri advised that he took 3 capsules within a 1 hour period. Based on Taheri appearance, being lethargic and being semi coherent, I transported Taheri to Bethesda Hospital East (BHE) for medical treatment. I arrived at BHE at approximately 2151hrs and Taheri was discharged at 2329hrs. Taheri was then transported to the Boynton Beach Police Department for further investigation. I arrived at the department at approximately 2332hrs, started my 20 minutes observation period at 2333hrs and ended it at 2353hrs. Upon completion I requested Taheri to provide a sample of his breath to determine the alcohol content, which he agreed to. Taheri provided a BAC of .000 at 2356hrs and .000 at 2359hrs. Due to that fact that I suspect Taheri to be under the influence of a Chemical and/or controlled substance I requested Taheri to provide a sample of his urine for the purpose of detecting the presence of a chemical or controlled substance, which he agreed to. All the proper documents were completed and the urine kit was later entered into Evidence Department; where it would later TOT PBSO's laboratory. I then advised Taheri of his Miranda Warnings, which he stated that he understood. I asked Taheri if he was willing to answer the question on this packet, which advised no.

Based on the above stated facts I have established Probable Cause to charge Taheri with 1M count of DUI pursuant with F.S.S. 316.193.1 and Possession of Heroin pursuant with F.S.S. 893.13.6A. Taheri was later TOT PBCJ.


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
Video from 4445, BAT video and Heroin were placed into BBPD evidence. Taheri's vehicle was removed from scene by Blake's towing.

Let it be noted that prior to leaving the scene I made contact with Stamatopoulos who advised that he first observed Taheri while he (Stamatopoulos) was at the intersection of Woolbright Rd and Congress Ave facing south. Stamatopoulos advised that while at the intersection he observed Taheri traveling southbound in the northbound lanes, just north of the intersection. Stamatopoulos advised that as the southbound traffic control device turned green Taheri switch into the southbound lanes and proceeded southbound at as high rate of speed. Stamatopoulos advised that Taheri failed to maintain a single a lane and was continuously "bouncing" off the center median. Stamatopoulos advised that he then contacted 911, which resulted to Delray Beach Police Department due to his location. Stamatopoulos advised that he followed Taheri south into Delray Beach, to the intersection of Atlantic Ave. Stamatopoulos advised that Taheri then made a u-turn and proceeded northbound on Congress Ave, back in Boynton Beach. Stamatopoulos advised that he was then transferred over to Boynton Beach communication, I which point the relayed the information. Stamatopoulos completed and signed a sworn statement.


