On Friday, August 9th, 2019, at approximately 1831 hours, I responded to Macy's Department Store, located on 801 North Congress Avenue, Boynton Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida 33436 in reference to a delayed shoplifting.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Loss Prevention Officers Zachary Dean and Richie Lott, as well as the shoplifting subject in question, later identified as W/F Shirlei Garcia.


Furthermore, contact with Loss Protection Officer Lott who stated that he was notified of a potential shoplifting subject within the store by Loss Prevention Officer Dean. LPO Lott was provided with Shirlei's clothing description, at which time he conducted floor surveillance. In addition, all store employees ensured no clothing items were left within any fitting rooms. LPO Lott observed Shirlei take possession of more than ten (10) clothing items and enter a fitting room. Upon exiting the fitting room, Shirlei was only carrying four (4) clothing items. In addition, the large paper bag in her possession was visibly more full. Shirlei then took possession of more merchandise to include a black Michael Kors purse before entering two (2) additional fitting rooms. Shirlei then passed all points of sale without any attempts to pay for the merchandise at the east entrance/exit. The merchandise not paid for by Shirlei was valued at \$401.77 pre-taxed USD. LPO Lott apprehended Shirlei without incident, at which time the above cited merchandise was recovered from her brown paper bag.


Contact was later made with LPO Dean who advised that he was notified by Security of a possible shoplifting in progress. Security personnel observed Shirlei removing a barcode tag from a hat. At this time LPO Dean observed Shirlei via uninterrupted cctv surveillance while LPO Lott observed Shirlei via foot surveillance. LPO Dean observed Shirlei enter multiple fitting rooms with merchandise; however, upon exiting, she was in possession of less items and her brown paper bag was fuller.

Furthermore, Shirlei was read her Miranda Rights which she verbally acknowledged she understood. Post Miranda, Shirlei advised she intended to steal some of the merchandise as gifts for family members and admitted to not paying for select items.

Based on both LPO Dean and LPO Lott's statements, Shirlei's statement, and my investigation, I find Probable Cause to place Shirlei Lima Garcia under arrest for 1M count of Retail Theft in violation of F.S.S. 812.01(2)(a). Shirlei was transported to BBPD for processing before later being turned over to the care, custody, and control of the Palm Beach County Jail.
