PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT  
 On 03/23/2018 at approximately 0135 hours, I responded to the area of N US Highway 1 and Burt Reynolds Park East in the Town of Jupiter, Palm Beach County, FL as a backup unit for Officer Turner who had conducted a traffic stop. At the time, I was driving a fully-marked Jupiter Police Department patrol vehicle (vehicle 1425), I was wearing a JPD issued uniform clearly identifying myself as a Jupiter Police Officer, and I was wearing my department-issued Axon body camera.  
 Upon arrival, I made contact with Officer Turner who advised the following: He was stopped on S.R. 706 (E Indiantown Rd.), facing east, in the outside left turn lane to turn left on N US Highway 1. He observed a white 2014 Jeep bearing FL tag # CRGG38 stopped, in the left through lane of eastbound S.R. 706 next to him. When the solid traffic control signal for through traffic changed to green, he observed the Jeep execute a left turn from the wrong lane. Officer Turner advised the traffic control signal for turning traffic displayed a red turn indicator at the time. Officer Turner advised he followed the vehicle, conducted a traffic stop, and identified the driver to be Stacy Guccione (w/f; 10/01/1971) by her valid Florida driver license. Officer Turner advised me that he observed Guccione had bloodshot, glassy eyes and had trouble remembering statements he made to her shortly after he made them. Officer Turner also advised that Guccione had slow and slurred speech.  
 I made contact with Guccione and observed she had bloodshot, glassy eyes. Guccione's voice was raspy and she advised that she had a cold. While speaking with Guccione, I noted the slight odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage, which was only detectable when she was looking at me while she was speaking. I noted that, although Guccione's voice was raspy, it appeared that some of her words were slurred. Several times while talking to Guccione, she would close her eyes and slowly open her eyelids while keeping her eyes looking at some unknown point above her.  
 Guccione initially advised that she was attempting to drive back home from her friend's residence and stated that she lived in the Bluffs. It should be noted that, at the time of the stop and shortly before, Guccione was traveling in the opposite direction of the Bluffs. When asked, Guccione advised that she believed she was traveling east; She was stopped in the northbound lanes of N US Highway 1, facing north. Guccione later advised that she was going to her boyfriend's house but could not provide a relative location or address. Guccione advised she did not have any alcoholic beverages prior to her driving but took Sudafed (over the counter medication) for her cold.  
 Due to my observations, I asked Guccione to exit her vehicle. Guccione complied and we walked to the front of my patrol vehicle, which I relocated to the front of the Guccione's vehicle and the police vehicles to protect us from passing traffic.  
 I requested that Guccione complete Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks and she agreed but immediately advised that she had a "horrible head cold" and that her "balance sucks as a normal person." I confirmed that Guccione was willing to do the tasks and she advised she did not know what her options were and that she would have to say yes. I explained that the tasks were voluntary and that it was her choice to complete the tasks or to refuse. I advised Guccione that if she refused, I would be forced to make an arrest decision on what I had observed so far and her refusal could be used as evidence against her in court (Taylor Warning).  
 Guccione began pleading for me to let her go and, when advised that that was not an option, she agreed to complete the tasks.

On the **23rd** day of **March** 20 **18** at **0218**  A.M.  P.M. (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

**Guccione advised she had a balance issue due to problems with her neck. She advised she needed surgery and stated that her neck was hitting her spinal cord. She advised it was "spatial dysplasia" but it did not affect the way she talks or the way her eyes move. Guccione advised she was not taking any prescription medications but that she took a "ridiculous amount of cough medicine."**

**While checking Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus, I observed lack of smooth pursuit in Guccione's left and right eyes. I observed distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both Guccione's left and right eyes. I did not observe the onset of nystagmus prior to 45-degrees in either eye. Guccione had to be reminded several times to keep her eyes on the stimulus and not move her head. While checking for Vertical Gaze Nystagmus, I observed VGN in Guccione's right eye but she quickly closed her eyes and advised "that just hurts my brain. That would normally hurt my brain." When asked if this was normal, Guccione advised her neck prevents her from looking up.**

**After checking HGN and VGN, Guccione advised that she was cold and I offered her a jacket from my vehicle. Guccione declined and advised that she felt like if she took the jacket that meant that I was keeping her. I advised her that she was not free to go and she asked what she had to do to be free to go. I advised Guccione that she could continue on with the SFSTs or refuse to complete them and again advised of her Taylor Warnings.**

**I asked Guccione if she wanted to continue and she again asked what her options were. I advised Guccione of her options and Taylor Warnings again. Guccione again asked what she had to do to go home and I advised her that she was beginning to talk in circles with me, as she had asked me that several times previously.**

**Guccione delayed several minutes pondering what her options were, to wear the jacket, and what could be done to get her home. At this time, Guccione began having mood swings and appeared to start crying but quickly stopped and asked me what I was going to request her to do.**

**I briefly explained the Walk and Turn, One Leg Stand, Finger to Nose, and Romberg Alphabet. Guccione advised that it was "not a drug thing" but that she could not stand on one leg.**

**I again asked if Guccione wished to continue with the Walk and Turn, Finger to Nose, and Romberg Alphabet and she agreed. I began giving instructions for the Walk and Turn task. After advising Guccione what the starting position was, Guccione quickly stepped off the line and took several steps around, advising that she was scared. I gave Guccione several seconds to compose herself and began giving instructions again. Guccione attempted to stand in the starting position and took a step off the line, to the right then severely stumbled to her left.**

**Guccione continually advised that she was stressed, nervous, and scared. I asked Guccione several more times if she would like to continue and she started asking again how she could get out of her current situation. I again advised Guccione that her options were to continue or refuse and force me to make an arrest decision on what I had seen of her so far.**

**Guccione began hyperventilating at various points and kept stating that she was scared. I attempted three more times to explain the Walk and Turn instructions to Guccione and never made it past the starting position instructions.**

(Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)</p> <p><b>Guccione was extremely indecisive and apparently unwilling to complete the tasks even though she advised she was trying to complete the tasks. Due to the fact that I had given Guccione multiple opportunities to make a decision and the fact that I was unable to administer instructions to Guccione, I determined that Guccione was unwilling to complete the tasks and determined that she was not going to complete the remainder of the SFSTs.</b></p> <p><b>Due to my observations of Guccione, I placed her under arrest for DUI. I placed handcuffs on her wrists which were checked for proper spacing and double-locked to prevent tightening. Officer Zeitz conducted a search incident to arrest of Guccione's person and I placed her in the rear passenger seat of my patrol vehicle.</b></p> <p><b>I transported Guccione to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing Facility where I conducted a 20 minute observation period to ensure she did not ingest or regurgitate anything orally. At the conclusion of the observation period, I requested Guccione provide a lawful sample of her breath for the purpose of determining the alcohol content. Guccione refused. I read Guccione Implied Consent from a prepared text and confirmed that she understood and requested she provide a breath sample. Guccione refused a second time.</b></p> <p><b>I read Guccione her Miranda Warnings and confirmed that she understood each one. I conducted a post-arrest, post-Miranda interrogation with Guccione and placed her in a holding cell while I completed the arrest paperwork.</b></p> <p><b>Due to my observations of Guccione (bloodshot, glassy eyes, odor of unknown alcoholic beverage which intensified as she spoke, mood swings, inability to recognize her whereabouts, driving away from her intended destination) and the fact that Guccione was apparently unwilling to complete the roadside tasks after being given numerous opportunities to do so, I believe probable cause exists to charge Guccione with DUI pursuant to FSS 316.193(1).</b></p>
