NARRATIVE: On May 24, 2019 I assisted Palm Beach Sheriff's Office District Six Deputies with a walk in complaint of a now 16-year-old student having inappropriate contact with his 23-year-old teacher. The victim, [REDACTED] is currently enrolled in High School as a student in the Palm Beach County School District. Victim's mother, [REDACTED] reported that on or about May 13, 2019 she hired Stacy Cabral to tutor her son [REDACTED]. Cabral was a substitute teacher at [REDACTED] school and was employed by the Palm Beach County School Board. Several tutoring sessions were arranged and occurred at the Palm Beach County Lantana Library located at 4020 Lantana Road in unincorporated Lake Worth, FL.

On May 17, 2019, [REDACTED] began suspecting an inappropriate relationship between [REDACTED] and Cabral. [REDACTED] observed text messages and photos on [REDACTED] phone that she believed were sexually suggestive in nature. [REDACTED] sent a text message to Cabral stating that she [REDACTED] viewed "behavior, photos and sexual language" between Cabral and [REDACTED] and told Cabral her tutoring services were no longer needed. Cabral responded with a text message stating "Yes, ma'am. I am so sorry. I will stay away from you both and never speak with you again. I am quitting my job effective immediately. I am so sorry." AND "I am unfit as far as teaching goes. I do want to inform you that I have never conducted myself this way before (not that it excuses my behavior) but there has never been another child and there never will be". Copies of the text messages were provided by [REDACTED].

On May 24, 2019 [REDACTED] observed a call on [REDACTED] phone. The call was at 1:05 a.m. and was between Cabral and [REDACTED]. Utilizing Find My iPhone [REDACTED] found [REDACTED] at 1609 16th Lane in Greenacres, FL (Cabral's residence). Cabral and [REDACTED] exited the home when confronted by [REDACTED]. On this same date [REDACTED] was interviewed. [REDACTED] admitted to his relationship escalating from teacher/student to "feelings for each other". [REDACTED] provided a recorded statement that he and Cabral were aware of the "Romeo and Juliet Law" and were allowed to date each other "as long as he was 16 and she was 24 and not a teacher". [REDACTED]

further stated that Cabral had quit her job as substitute teacher so that the two could "continue dating". [REDACTED] stated that Cabral "ordered an Uber" for him so that they could be together at her home where [REDACTED] confronted them. [REDACTED] is in love with Cabral and provided minimal details about his relationship with her. [REDACTED] agreed to a consensual forensic download of [REDACTED] phone. It was then that [REDACTED] admitted he had sent "dick picks" to Cabral.

On July 9, 2019 subpoena results for phone number of (561) 572-1544 were received from T-Mobile confirming that the phone number did in fact belong to Cabral. Call logs were returned indicating that from the time period of May 11, 2019 through and including May 24, 2019 there were 94 calls and/or text messages incoming and outgoing from Cabral to [REDACTED]. The calls ranged 1second to as high as 1 hour, 10 minutes and 45 seconds in total and occurred primarily throughout the overnight hours between 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

On July 19, 2019 the forensic download of [REDACTED] phone was reviewed. [REDACTED] attempted to delete and/or hide images and videos. The forensic download indicates where [REDACTED] deleted files including call logs and messages. A note recovered in the "notes" application on [REDACTED] phone was titled "Stacy my love" and included Stacy Cabral's home address. There were numerous photos of a clothed Cabral on the phone. The clothes that Cabral was wearing in the photos matched several of the nude videos and images found on the phone. Over 30 images and videos involving a naked female performing sexual acts on herself were recovered in the forensic download. Of the 30 images and videos viewed, the following specifically reveal sexual performance by Cabral:



- a. TYIQs:100 - image depicting a Snap Chat filtered photo of Stacy Cabral topless and exposing her breasts.
- b. ddmJZ:100 - video begins with Stacy Cabral standing with her shirt pulled up exposing her breasts and wearing pink underwear. She removes her underwear and videos herself fully nude. The video focuses on a skin blemish to the right side of her neck commonly referred to as a "hickey" (marked caused by sucking of the skin).
- c. O0j5H:100 - video depicting a female wearing the same shirt and underwear as in previously described video. Female is lying down on a rug, moves her pink underwear to one side and uses her fingers to masturbate. There are messages at the end of the video saying "Bella Nooooo". Investigation revealed "Bella" is [REDACTED] nickname for Stacy Cabral.
- d. IMG_0282.mov - video depicting a female lying down on the same rug as seen in video O0j5H:100. Female is only wearing laced blue underwear and is exposing her breasts. Visible is the same necklace as seen in Cabral's ddmJZ:100 video described above.
- e. group.com.keepsafe.KeepSafe.plist_embedded_1.jpg Snap shot photo taken from Cabral's sexually explicit Video ddmJZ:100
- f. group.com.keepsafe.KeepSafe.plist_embedded_2.jpg Snap shot photo taken from Cabral's sexually explicit Video ddmJZ:100
- g. group.com.keepsafe.KeepSafe.plist_embedded_2.jpg Snap shot photo taken from Cabral's sexually explicit Video ddmJZ:100

NARRATIVE CONTINUATION

On July 30, 2019, The Honorable Judge Kirk Volker signed a residential search warrant for Cabral's residence located at 1609 16th Lane in the City of Greenacres, FL (Palm Beach County). The search warrant was executed on August 1, 2019 by Detectives from the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Warrants Unit and Special Investigations Division – Computer Crimes Unit.

Cabral was interviewed and Post Miranda confessed to having an inappropriate romantic relationship with [REDACTED] while she was a substitute teacher for the Palm Beach School Board and he was a student in her class that she also tutored. Cabral described the relationship as hugging, kissing, holding hands and oral sex. She further stated that the two would spend hours on the phone at which time the calls would escalate and become sexual. Cabral admitted to sharing Snap Chat Live Videos of her naked and masturbating more than 10 times but less than 20. The Snap Chat videos were transmitted electronically over the internet while she was home on her living room couch. Cabral acknowledged that [REDACTED] also shared nude photos of himself with her and that she knew what she was doing was wrong.

Based on my investigation and evidence gathered, I find probable cause that Cabral did willfully and intentionally produce and transmit harmful images and videos depicting sexual conduct to a known minor in violation of F.S.S. 847.0138, intentionally solicited and enticed a known minor to engage in sexual conduct by use of electronic device in violation of F.S.S. 847.0135(3)(a), utilized a two-way device to commit aforementioned violations, in violation of F.S.S. 934.215 and, while working as a teacher, engaged in lewd conduct with a minor that she knew to be a student, in violation of F.S.S. 800.101(3). Cabral was placed under arrest and transported to the Main Jail.
