

On the **2** day of **June**, **2018** at **21:48** (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On Saturday, June 2, 2018 at approximately 2116 hours Ofc Hobby ID386 stopped a black vehicle, bearing FL tag HHZS69, for having an expired registration and also driving erratically. Ofc Hobby told me that he got behind the vehicle because of the expired tag but as he followed the vehicle it was not able to maintain a lane and made several other traffic infractions. Ofc Hobby said that the vehicle crossed the solid white fog line, would abruptly change lanes, and slowed down and sped up erratically. Ofc Hobby said he initiated a traffic stop and the vehicle came to stop in the left turning lane just after Maplewood Dr in front of Jupiter First Church. Ofc Hobby told me that he then made contact with the driver, identified via her FL DL as Stephanie C LaFever (W/F 02/01/1979), of the vehicle. Ofc Hobby said that he had LaFever step out of the vehicle to speak with her. Ofc Hobby told me that he could smell an odor of an unknown alcoholic substance coming off LaFever's person and he observed that she had glassy eyes. About this time I arrived on scene to conduct a DUI investigation. Please see Ofc Hobby's supplemental report for detail of his initial contact.

Upon arrival I made contact with LaFever and informed her that from what I was told by Ofc Hobby I believed she was driving under the influence. I observed that LaFever had glassy eyes and I could detect an odor of an unknwn alcoholic substance coming from her person. I told LaFever that I would like her to perform some roadside tasks. LaFever interrupted me and said that she would rather not; she said that she was out "partying and drinking" all day. LaFever said that she had one beer around two in the afternoon. I asked LaFever where she as at and she told me Rialto. Rialto is a gated community in Jupiter on Island Way north of W Indiantown Rd. LaFever repeatedly interrupted me and asked about her daughter. I told LaFever that we would call a family to come pick up her daughter but right now we were in the middle of an investigation. LaFever told me that she felt uncomfortable being in only her bathing suit. I asked LaFever if she had clothes in her car and she was unable to tell me for certain if she did. LaFever's car was checked for pants that she could wear but nothing was found. At this time I told

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

LaFever again that I was requesting that she perform some roadside tasks. LaFever continued to not answer my question. I informed LaFever of her taylor warnings and asked her again if she would perform the tasks. LaFever continued to ignore my question and begin yelling at her daughter to call her father. At this time I placed LaFever under arrest for DUI. I placed LaFever into handcuffs, checking for spacing and double locking them. I placed LaFever in the back of my patrol car and buckled her seat belt.

I then transported LaFever to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing Facility. I conducted a 20 minute observation period to ensure that LaFever did not take anything by mouth or regurgitate. I then requested LaFever provide a sample of her breath. She agreed immediately. LaFever provided two samples of .154 and .156. I read LaFever her Miranda Rights from a prepared text. LaFever invoked her rights. I secured LaFever in a holding cell and completed my paperwork.

I subsequently booked LaFever into the Palm Beach County Jail where I charged her with DUI per FSS 316.193(4) (1).

My Axon body worn camera was utilized. Ofc Hobby recorded the incident using his vehicles dashcam, veh1808, and the video was entered into Jupiter PD evidence.
