The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe, and does believe that the above named Defendant committed the following violation of law. [] committed the below acts in my presence. [] was observed by _____ who told me that he/she saw the arrested person commit the below acts. [] confessed to _____ admitting to the below facts. [X] was found to have committed the below acts, resulting from my (described) investigation. On the 29th day of October 2017 at 2216 [] A.M. [X] P.M. (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

I explained to Steven the reason I was speaking with him stating that the other deputy believed he may be impaired so he called me. Steven stated he understood what that meant. As Steven stood still I observed that he had a slow front to back sway. Since Steven was already in handcuffs and under arrest for resisting an officer without violence I decided to read him his Constitutional Warnings. Steven stated he understood his rights after they were read to him.

I asked Steven if he was already checked out by Fire Rescue and cleared without any serious injuries to which he stated, "no" as if he had no injuries. Steven shook his head no to the question of having any medical issues such as diabetes or seizures. Steven stated he had no issues with his eyes that were not corrected by glasses or contacts. He also stated he did not wear glasses or contacts. He shook his head no to having any physical defects or injuries other than the scratch on his right leg. I asked him if he took any prescription medication at which time he did not say or do anything. I asked Steven if he had anything to drink that night at which time he shook his head no again. I asked him about the Grey Goose Vodka located in his vehicle to which he stated that it was given to him and he does not drink at all. Steven repeated that he did not drink at all several times.

I observed that Steven's speech appeared mumbled, slurred, unclear, and slow as he spoke. He was also repetitive with his speech. Steven became increasingly aggravated throughout my interaction with him. He stated that he was brining the vodka home for his girlfriend who drinks.

Due to the fact that Steven had attempted to flee several times and had been placed into handcuffs already I decided that SFSTs were not able to be done at that time for fear that he may attempt to flee once the handcuffs were removed. I did request to check Steven's eyes (conduct the HGN task). Steven started to turn away from uttering something unintelligible and me telling me to put him in the car several times.


I explained my observations to Steven and asked him why I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage was coming from his mouth if he didn't drink. Steven repeated that he didn't drink several more times. I attempted to have Steven conduct the HGN task but he refused to. I explained to Steven Taylor Warnings at that time. Steven continued to be uncooperative as I was speaking with him. He continued to become more agitated and aggressive with me as well as interrupting me as I spoke. I again explained Taylor Warnings to him. Steven continued to divert his answer to the task. I asked Steven one last time if I could check his eyes to which he stated no. He was then advised he was being placed under arrest for the DUI as well.

During an inventory of the vehicle I located on the front passenger floor board a open clear plastic cup containing an unknown alcoholic beverage in side of it. The liquid was reddish in color. There was also an open container of Tropicana Cranberry Juice on the passenger seat. It should be noted that Vodka and Cranberry is a common drink which is consumed together.

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On 10/29/2017 at approximately 2243 hours I responded to the area of Linton Blvd and Glencrest Ave, in unincorporated Palm Beach County, in reference to a DUI investigation. Upon my arrival at the guard gate located at 8060 Linton Blvd I observed a white Kia Sorento bearing Florida tag CGIX85 stopped in front of the closed gate to the community. I observed a white male wearing a dark blue t-shirt, black shorts, and black shoes was handcuffed sitting on the curb of the median. Palm Beach County Fire Rescue had already been on scene to medically clear the driver of the Kia, Steven Hinesley, who was also the person handcuffed (reference run number 17116974). I then spoke to the original stopping deputy, D/S E. Ritacco ID: 26732 who stated to me the following: He initially saw the Kia run a stop sign at the intersection of Legends Way and Linton Blvd traveling westbound without slowing down. He had caught up with the Kia at the same guard gate we were currently at. D/S Ritacco conducted a traffic stop of the Kia and as the gate started to open the Kia attempted to pull through it but D/S Ritacco tapped on the vehicle to have it stop.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

He walked up to the vehicle and observed that Steven, who was identified through his Florida issued driver's license, was acting strange, weird, and had a glossed over look. As D/S Ritacco asked Steven for his license and registration he observed that Steven was fumbling around looking for the documents (dexterity issues). Steven was unable to provide his registration or insurance. He advised Steven to wait in the vehicle so that could run the information. D/S Ritacco stated that he could smell the odor of alcohol on Steven. D/S Guevara ID: 19475 provided backup for D/S Ritacco and according to him could also smell the odor of alcohol on Steven. D/S Guevara had located in plain view a open bottle of Grey Goose Vodka (375 ml) on the passenger front seat. Steven got out of his vehicle multiple times, was ordered back in the vehicle, and attempted to walk away from the scene into the gated community (where his address was located). Steven got more belligerent with D/S Ritacco through the course of the stop. They had to stand with him to make sure he did not flee the scene. Steven again attempted to flee the scene and in doing so was stopped by D/S Ritacco and D/S Guevara inside of the gated community a few feet west of the scene. D/S Guevara had deployed his dart firing stun gun to gain compliance from Steven. He was then handcuffed and returned back to the immediate area of the stop. D/S Ritacco stated that Steven sustained a small scratch on his right leg during the course of him being taken into custody. (See D/S Ritacco and D/S Guevara's supp PCs for further). The over head blue lights were turned off prior to interviewing Steven.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

I then made contact with Steven who was still handcuffed sitting on the curb. I immediately observed that his eyes were very red, blooshot, glassy, and droopy. His face appeared flush and red. As I got close to him I could smell the obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his person. He did not appear wet as if he had spilled something on him. I asked him is he was okay at which time he mumbled "yea" to me. I asked him if he was explained to why he was in handcuffs to which he also stated "yea." I assisted Steven to his feet so that I could walk him to the front of my PBSD marked patrol vehicle. In doing so I observed that his muscle tone appeared flaccid (soft and loose). The odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage was also very obvious the closer I got to him. He appeared dazed as well. (See attached PC for further)

ODORS:

Obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on his breath as he spoke

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: Slurred, unclear, mumbled

ATTITUDE: Non-compliant, resistant, confrontational

CLOTHING: Blue polo shirt, black shorts, black shoes

MEDICAL/OTHER: No medical issues (no diabetes or seizures), no physical defects or injuries, no issues with eyes (no noted glasses or contacts), stated does not drink multiple times



While on patrol in the 7400 Block of Linton Blvd. I observed a white sport utility traveling Westbound approaching a stop sign at the intersection of Legends Way at a high rate of speed approximately 40 miles per hour. I observed the vehicle travel through the intersection without making an attempt to stop at the stop sign. I positioned my marked patrol car behind the vehicle and activated my emergency lights to effect a traffic stop on a white Kia sport utility bearing Florida tag CGIX85 at the gated entrance to the Casa Bella development located at 8060 Linton Blvd. As I approached the drivers side of the vehicle the car began to creep forward as the gate was opening for vehicular traffic. I had to tap on the side of the car to get the drivers attention to have him stop the car. I met with the driver later identified as Steven Michael Hinesley W/M 07-12-1982 as per his Florida Drivers License. I requested his license and registration paperwork for the vehicle. Hinesley struggled to find his paperwork fumbling with assorted papers in the car. He did produce a Florida Drivers License at which time I instructed him to remain at his vehicle as I ran his information. I noticed Hinesley appeared disoriented had slurred speech and also observed an odor of alcohol coming from the vehicle. I requested a DUI unit respond at this time for further investigation. As I began the process of running his information Hinesley exited his vehicle to address deputies on the scene and he was instructed to remain in his vehicle. Moments later Hinesley exited his vehicle again and began to walk westbound into the gated community. I responded to his location in front of his vehicle and explained to him that we were conducting an investigation and that he was not free to leave. Hinesley was argumentative and was escorted back to the side of his vehicle. Moments later Hinesley began to walk away from his vehicle toward the inside of the community, where his home is located. Deputy Guevara gave him instructions to stop and he began to run away from the scene of the traffic stop. Hinesley was pursued inside the gated area onto a grassy swale where he was taken into custody after a tazer deployment by D/S Guevara. Hinesley was hand cuffed, treated by PBCFR for and turned over to DUI units for follow up investigation.



ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2017 AT APPROXIMATELY 2216 HOURS I RESPONDED AS BACK-UP TO A TRAFFIC STOP AT THE ENTRANCE OF CASABELLA LOCATED AT 8060 LINTON BLVD, DELRAY BEACH FL 33446. THE DRIVER WHO WAS IDENTIFIED BY HIS FL DRIVER'S LICENSE AS (W/M) STEVEN HINESLEY DOB (7/12/1982. HINESLEY APPEARED TO BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF AN UNKNOWN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE AS HE HAD A STRONG ODOR OF ALCOHOL COMING FROM THE INSIDE OF THE VEHICLE WHITE KIA BEARING FL TAG "CGIX85" AND HIS EYES WERE BLOOD SHOT.

IN PLAIN VIEW I OBSERVED AN OPEN ALCOHOL CONTAINER WHICH WAS HALF WAY FULL. HINESLEY TURN THE VEHICLE OFF AND THEN BACK ON FOR NO APPARENT REASON. I THEN ASKED HIM TO HAND ME HIS KEYS WHICH HE COMPLAINED. D/S RITACCO #26732 CONTACTED A DUI UNIT TO CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION AS HE APPEARED TO BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL. HINESLEY STEPPED OUT OF THE VEHICLE SEVERAL TIMES AND REFUSED MY COMMANDS TO STAY INSIDE THE VEHICLE. HE STEPPED OUT OF THE VEHICLE AND STARTED TO WALK AWAY FROM US, HE WAS ASKED TO STOP, AND THAT HE WAS NOT FREE TO LEAVE. A FEW SECONDS LATER HE BEGAN TO RUN AWAY FROM MYSELF AND D/S RITACCO RUNNING WEST BOUND THOUGH THE ENTRANCE OF THE COMMUNITY. I STAYED A FEW FEET BEHIND HIM AND YELLED FOR HIM TO STOP.

HINESLEY FAILED TO COMPLY SO I DREW PBSO ISSUED X26 TASER S/N X0-575873 AND AIMED IT TOWARDS HIM. I PLACED A SHOT ON HIS BACK WHICH HAD GOOD EFFECT AS IT RENDERED HIM IMMOBILE. AFTER ASKING HIM SEVERAL TIMES TO PLACE HIS HANDS BEHIND HIS BACK HE COMPLIED WITH THE COMMANDS. TWO SETS OF HANDCUFFS WERE USED WHICH WERE DOUBLE LOCKED AND CHECKED FOR PROPER FIT. PBR #245 RESPONDED TO THE SCENE REF RUN # 17-116974 AND TREATED HINESLEY FOR A MINOR CUT TO HIS RIGHT LEG WHICH HE SUSTAINED AFTER FALLING TO THE GROUND. GIVEN THE ABOVE FACTS THERE IS PROBABLE CAUSE TO ARREST HINESLEY FOR RESISTING WITHOUT VIOLENCE CONTRARY TO F.S.S 843.02. HE WAS TURNED OVER TO D/S FICARRA #8386 TO CONDUCT THE DUI INVESTIGATION.


