**Narrative**

On Thursday, March 15, 2018, I, Officer L. Beckford of the Ocean Ridge Police Department in the Town of Ocean Ridge, County of Palm Beach, and State of Florida, responded to a domestic violence call at 5520 N Ocean Blvd unit 109.

I arrived with Sergeant S. McClure and Officer J. Van Camp at approximately 0408 hours and observed a white female, later identified as Halena Ramos (DOB: 08/18/1974), standing outside of her door with her cell phone to her ear. I made contact with Halena and she immediately starting telling me what had occurred between her and her current boyfriend, later identified as Stolson J. Bernard (DOB: 04/25/1984). Halena stated Stolson was currently drunk and high from cough medicine, beer and tequila. Halena stated she got into a verbal altercation with Stolson that turned physical. Halena stated Stolson began to break glass, break her coffee pot, and throw clothing around their residence. Halena stated she asked Stolson to leave the residence and he refused. Halena stated she went to try to lie down on the couch and he followed her at which time he used a small hand-held bat to choke her out. Halena stated she can recall passing out for a few minutes. Halena stated during the time of Stolson throwing items in the house he broke her television that is located in the living room. Halena also stated that this incident took place at approximately 0200 hours.

I asked Halena if she needed medical attention, she refused. While I was talking with Halena she opened her front door and walked inside to show proof that Stolson had damage her television and broken glass was on the floor. While speaking to her, the assisting Officers searched the residence for Stolson but did not locate him. Halena stated prior to our arrival, Stolson was still inside of the residence and he probably left out of the rear door of the residence since he was no longer present. The assisting Officers then conducted a search of the area attempting to locate Stolson with negative results. I asked Halena did she give Stolson permission to commit battery on her, she stated no. I asked Halena if she would provide a written sworn statement attesting to the information she provided to be true. She agreed to complete a written statement but refused to press charges. Halena completed a Refusal to Cooperate form. I made contact with the Victim Advocate hotline and spoke with Darlene ID #63, whom stated she will make a record of this incident.

When I walked into the residence, I observed a broken beer bottle on the floor near the living room window, broken glass on the floor near the front door and in the kitchen area and clothing thrown over the floor. I also observed the living room television screen was cracked. I asked Halena for a description of Stolson, she stated he was a tall white male wearing blue shorts and no shoes. Halena stated Stolson probably walked over to his father's residence at 5505 N Ocean BLVD 109.

I examined Halena's neck area and found no visible marks or bruises. I took pictures of Halena's neck area. I also photographed the living room and kitchen. I provided Halena with a copy of the Domestic Violence Victim Rights packet.

We left Halena's residence and went to the address she provided as Stolson's father address. I made contact with Stolson's father, who stated he did not see his son tonight. He allowed the assisting Officers to walk into his house and verify his son was not present. We were unable to make contact with Stolson.

I packaged the memory card from the digital camera and submitted it as evidence. The memory card was secure into evidence locker #2.

On Thursday, March 15, 2018, at approximately 2215 hours I went back to the residence of Halena as a follow-up attempting to locate Stolson; to no avail. I was able to retrieve the weapon (a wooden bat) that Stolson utilized to strangle Halena. The bat belongs to Halena, I completed a property release form which Halena signed agreeing for the weapon to be submitted as evidence. I also did a follow-up at his father's residence but was not able to locate Stolson.

Due to the information listed above, I found probable cause to submit a warrant request for Stolson pursuant to FSS 784.041.2a. Stolson did knowingly and intentionally, against the will of Halena, impede the normal breathing or circulation of the blood of a Halena with whom he is in a dating relationship, so as to create a risk of or cause great bodily harm by applying pressure on her throat or neck.

On Tuesday, March 20, 2018, I, Officer L. Beckford of the Ocean Ridge Police Department in the Town of Ocean Ridge, County of Palm Beach, and State of Florida, responded to the Police Station in reference to a follow-up with a Domestic Violence case #2018-0072.

At approximately 1657 hours, Stolson John Bernard entered into the Town of Ocean Ridge Police Department to provide a sworn statement in reference to the incident that took place on March 15, 2018. I read Stolson his Miranda rights and he sign the card stating he understood his rights. Stolson provided a tape sworn statement stating he did have a physical altercation with the victim (Ramos) and believed he did utilized the wooden bat to choke her.

Due to the statement provided by Bernard, he was placed under arrest for felony battery (DV) pursuant to F.S.S 784.041.2A. Bernard was transported to the Palm Beach County Jail.






