PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On the above date and time, I responded to the area of Camino Real and Camino Del Mar in reference to a vehicle accident involving a possible impaired driver. Upon arrival, I met with D/S Jensen #9582. D/S Jensen advised that he arrived to help with the crash and was directed down Camino Del Mar to a white Honda Accord bearing FL tag LIJ267. Upon arrival he met with W/F Susan Peltz who driving the white Honda. He noticed articulable indicators of impairment and requested a DUI unit respond. He completed a supplemental probable cause affidavit detailing his observations.

I next spoke to witness Justin Jackson. Jackson was the passenger in other vehicle involved in the crash. After the crash occurred, Jackson observed the white 4-door travel South on Camino Del Mar away from the crash. He exited the vehicle and followed it until it stopped. He identified the driver as a W/F with blonde hair and around 5'2" tall. He was able to identify the driver on scene as Peltz

Based on evidence and witness statements, I determined the following: V1 (White Honda bearing FL tag LIJ267.) was traveling Westbound on Camino Real and made a left turn to travel South on Camino Del Mar. V1 did not yield to oncoming V2 and entered the intersection in front of it causing V2 to strike the right rear fender of V1 with its front right bumper.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Upon making contact with the driver who was identified by her Florida driver license as Susan Peltz, I immediately detected an obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from her person and breath. This odor intensified as I spoke to her. She had glassy, and blood shot eyes. Peltz's speech was slurred, and thick. Her movements were slow and deliberate, and lethargic with poor coordination. She had an unsteady gait while walking to my patrol vehicle and had difficulty maintaining her balance. Peltz also had difficulty following directions given to. She was wearing a multi-colored t-shirt, denim jeans, and blue sandals.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

POST MIRANDA - Admitted to driving the vehicle at the time of the crash. Peltz stated that she had 1 and a half glasses of wine after coming from Mizner Park and a Jimmy Buffet tribute band.

ODORS:

An obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her person and breath which became stronger as she spoke.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: Peltz's speech was slurred and thick.

ATTITUDE: Talkative and annoyed

CLOTHING: Multi-colored shirt with denim pants and blue sandals.

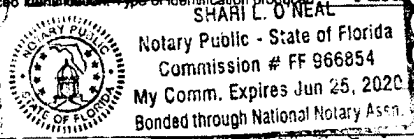

Other Observations:

Peltz would sway in a side to side front to back pattern throughout the task. She was reminded to follow the stimulus with her eyes and her eyes only.

WALK & TURN:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Walk & Turn" to Peltz who stated that she understood. During the task, I observed her to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. She could not maintain her balance while listening to instructions. She stepped out of the instructional stance during the demonstration to catch her balance. Peltz started the task before being instructed to do so. Peltz missed heel-to-toe steps and performed an improper turn. Additionally, she performed the incorrect number of steps by only walking 8 steps even though she counted 9.

ONE LEG STAND:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "One Leg Stand" to Peltz who stated that she understood. During the task, I observed her to sway in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. She continued to sway while balancing on one leg. She started hopping in an attempt to maintain balance. Peltz put her foot down to regain balance numerous times before the 30 seconds had elapsed.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Finger to Nose" task to Peltz who stated that she understood. During the task, I observed her to sway in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Peltz's index finger did not touch the tip of the nose on 5 of 6 attempts. The sequence used for this task was L, R, L, R, L, R.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Rhombert Alphabet" task to Peltz who stated that she understood. During the task, I observed her to sway in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Peltz would sway more than 2 inches.
