

<p>On the <u>25</u> day of <u>June</u> <u>2017</u> at <u>22:06</u> (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)</p> <p>On Sunday, June 25, 2017, at 1854 hours, I responded to Walmart located at 2144 W. Indiantown Rd. in reference to an in progress shoplifting. The caller, Loss Prevention Officer Michael Rene (W/M 12/01/87), advised that two black females were in the Garden Center concealing merchandise in their purses. They were described as one wearing blue jeans, black shirt and curly hair and the other in blue jeans, a colorful shirt, and riding on an electric cart. Rene advised they were concealing clothes and cosmetics and had a lot of merchandise on them. Rene then advised they were both at self-checkout scanning items that were not concealed, but still had more items concealed. The subjects then left out the Garden Center exit, passing all points of sale.</p> <p>Officer Counts and I were waiting at the Garden Center Exit and approached the females along with Rene. Rene confronted them and advised them that he witnessed the subjects stealing merchandise. There were multiple Walmart plastic bags with merchandise in the electric cart and purses filled with more merchandise. The subjects were cooperative and walked to the Loss Prevention Office with us. The subjects were identified as Tiffany E. Goldson (B/F 8/30/91) and Nathalie C. Hosey (B/F 2/8/84).</p> <p>Rene reported that he observed the following via floor surveillance: He began watching the subjects after his manager Michael Furbee (W/M 2/12/88) witnessed the two subjects opening an electronic package in the electronics department and alerted him. He then witnessed the females selecting multiple items in the cosmetics section and placing them next to an open purse in an electric shopping cart. They continued around the store selecting more merchandise. They moved to the rear of the store in the automotive section and they sorted through all the merchandise and together concealed it into different purses. They then went to the back restroom where Hosey went inside and left Goldson with the merchandise and cart. He continued watching them and witnessed them select clothing items and a black purse. They then went back to cosmetics and selected more merchandise and placed it in the cart. They went into the Garden Center where they</p>


removed the hangers from the clothing and concealed more cosmetics into the bags. They both proceeded to the self-checkout and began ringing up merchandise. They made no attempt to pay for the merchandise concealed into the purses or pay for the makeup bags that contained merchandise. They then proceeded past all points of sale where he introduced himself along with Jupiter Police. They could not provide a receipt of the transaction and it had to be pulled up from the computer system. The only merchandise purchased was the pack of Pepsi, Life Water, and a pack of women's underwear. Walmart would like to prosecute and have the subjects trespass indefinitely. He completed a written statement.

Furbee reported that he observed the following via floor surveillance: He witnessed Hosey and Goldson in the Electronics Department with a power bank charger. She removed the product from the packaging and plugged it into her phone. He then alerted Rene and witnessed the above with Rene. He advised he witnessed them at the self-checkout handing some clothing items to the associate stating they did not want it all. He completed a written statement.

While at the Loss Prevention Office Goldson said that she did not get a receipt for her transaction, but that she thinks she paid cash for approximately sixty-four dollars worth of merchandise. Loss Prevention searched through the system for any transaction matching the items she said she paid for, but one was not located. She then admitted that she did go to the Electronic Section and opened a package for a portable charger and swapped it with one she had bought previously that was broken. She said she didn't think anything was wrong with doing this because she paid for the broken one. I asked her why she did not bring it to customer service to exchange it and she said because Jupiter has bad customer service compared to Wellington. I read Miranda to Goldson, which she advised she understood.

Post Miranda Goldson said she did not pay for the makeup bag or any of the contents inside. She did not know how many or exactly what it was she took, she just knows it was miscellaneous makeup. She advised that both of them filled up the purses and put it in the electric cart. She said she was aware that they were both stealing and working together. She admitted that she did buy the Pepsi. I questioned her about the receipt of the purchased items and told her that the Pepsi was on the same receipt as the items Hosey is admitting to pay for and that they could not find any other transaction. They both admitted that they both used the same one transaction. While in the cells, Goldson said to Hosey, "I knew it was a bad idea, we took too much stuff". Goldson completed a written statement and said she switched out the charger that didn't work by opening a new package. She paid for items and walked out with Hosey who she thought paid for the purse. She took a bag with three to four items in it and she thought it all rung up, but it did not. She had \$400 in her bag and could have paid for it. She also said she knew Hosey had items she didn't pay for.

While in the Loss Prevention Office Hosey admitted to stealing and said "I stole, I got caught, just tell me if you are arresting me or not". Post Miranda Hosey advised that she wanted the black purse and really liked it and did not have enough money, so she stole it. She then said she decided to just start throwing things in the purse to conceal them that she wanted. She said she remembered putting a shower scrubber, and miscellaneous cosmetics. She said she did pay for the flip flops she was wearing and underwear. While in the holding cell she told Goldson "I was just grabbing shiny shit, I didn't even see what I was taking". She told Goldson she took so much stuff she could see how it added up and that she did steal the purse and just threw everything in it.

The following items were stolen in coordination between the two of them: two train cases \$9.84 each, lychee scrub \$6.48, two body spray \$4.97 each, necklace \$4.88, bronzer \$12.97, two Bway impress \$5.97 each, impress \$5.97, lipstick \$4.97, tote \$22.97, power bank charger \$19.87, nail polish \$5.84, mascara \$5.47, 5 piece set \$13.98, LDSBAN45WM \$5.00, phy argan \$12.97, eyeliner \$5.00, mascara \$7.97, toenail polish \$7.97, foundation \$13.23, eyeliner \$5.97, CG melt pout \$6.94, necklace \$4.88, two Kathykat Matte \$6.94 each, concealer \$8.97, eyeliner \$7.94, foundation \$14.97, eyeliner \$7.97, kabuki brush \$7.97, Loreal Pari \$7.97, lip crème \$7.97, concealer \$8.97, concealer \$7.94, Kokie \$6.98, primer \$10.97, Maybelline face \$9.98, eyeshadow \$6.97. The total value of all items was \$344.34 before taxes.

The above gave me probable cause to charge both Goldson and Hosey with AGGRAVATED GRAND RETAIL THEFT, because they did commit Retail Theft of the above property valued at \$300 or more and individually, or in concert with one or more other persons, coordinated the activities of one or more individuals in committing the offense; or acted in concert with one or more other individuals within one or more establishments to distract the merchant, merchant's employee, or law enforcement officer in order to carry out the offense, or acted in other ways to coordinate efforts to carry out the offense; or, committed the offense through the purchase of merchandise in a package or box that contained merchandise other than, or in addition to, the merchandise purported to be contained in the package according to FSS 812.015(1)(d) and (8) .
