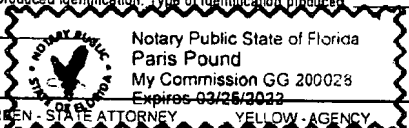

I was traveling southbound on State Road 7 within the inside lane when I observed a black Ford F150 pickup truck bearing Florida tag BUUZ36 traveling southbound in the outside lane behind my vehicle. The vehicle was traveling at a high rate of speed and my in-car Stalker Radar DB011690 rear antennae gave a reading of 85 miles per hour, which matched my visual estimation of the speed. Roadway speed limit signs were properly posted directing traffic to a maximum of 50 miles per hour. I immediately changed lanes, activated my emergency lights and siren, and conducted a traffic stop on the pick-up. I made contact with the driver/defendant who I later identified as Todd Michael Bernstein (date of birth 6/29/1981) after he provided me with his Florida license (B652-813-81-229-0). I immediately smelled a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from Mr. Bernstein's breath when he spoke to me. He acknowledged he had been speeding and told me he had consumed a beer. While still seated in his driver's seat, I asked him to follow the tip of my finger while keeping his head still. I began to check if his eyes tracked appropriately and displayed lack of smooth pursuit. He had a hard time following the tip of my finger. He began to follow my finger and then he stopped tracking the stimulus and looked straight ahead as if he was looking through me. I asked him again to follow the tip of my finger with his eyes and keep his head still. He followed the stimulus and I noted his eyes tracked appropriately, he displayed lack of smooth pursuit, and his angle of onset began prior to 45 degrees (I didn't estimate how quickly the nystagmus began, because I did not perform the entire task due to him sitting in the vehicle). I met with Investigator Alan Soloway #8288 of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office DUI Enforcement Unit who was also on-scene and I turned the DUI investigation over to him. I was present during the investigation as a back-up officer. I observed the defendant perform the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus task with Inv. Soloway and the completed portion of the Walk and Turn task. During the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus task, the defendant displayed all six clues of impairment. He had a hard time following the stimulus and he had to be re-instructed numerous times to follow the stimulus. The driving pattern of the defendant, the traffic stop, and the subsequent interactions with the defendant were captured on my in-car camera (refer to video). The defendant's girlfriend, Natalie Bella Bak (date of birth 9/10/1997) was with the defendant and positioned within the right front passenger seat of the vehicle. I remained with her until her friend arrived, per her request, to take her home from the scene. According to Miss Bak, she was too impaired to drive the pick-up truck home. Before she departed the scene, she requested I have the pick-up towed; therefore, I had Gardens Towing dispatched to the scene. I completed a Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Vehicle Storage Receipt and I provided a copy of the form to Miss Bak and later to the defendant.

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

I was traveling southbound on State Road 7 just south of Hypoluxo Rd. when I observed a black pick up traveling at a high rate of speed in the outside lane. This pick up began to pass me as I was in the inside lane. I visually estimated this vehicle to be traveling in excess of 80 MPH in a posted 50 MPH zone. I observed Inv. R. Stephan #7240 traveling directly behind the pick up and Stephan had already activated his emergency lights in an attempt to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle. Stephan advised me he was attempting to stop the vehicle for traveling 85 MPH in a posted 50 MPH. Stephan obtained this speed using his moving radar #DB011690 rear antenna.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

The driver was sitting in the driver's seat when Inv. Stephan and I stopped his vehicle. He identified himself by his Florida Driver License, as Todd Bernstein. There was a female sitting in the front passenger seat who he stated was his girlfriend. The driver's eyes were red and glassy. I could smell and odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's breath.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

The driver stated he was coming from a wedding and was heading home. He said he only had one alcoholic beverage at 2-3pm. The driver stated he did not have any medical conditions and denied using and medication or illegal drugs. He stated he was told not to perform roadside tasks because even if you are not impaired you still fail them. He asked me if his girlfriend could just drive them home.

I could smell and odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's breath.

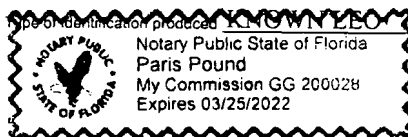

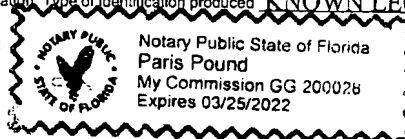
