Upon completion of the Finger to Nose task, Ward was instructed and I then demonstrated how to perform the Romberg Alphabet task. Ward was asked his highest level of education, and he stated he had completed a few years of college. Ward was asked if he thought he could complete the English alphabet from A to Z, and stated that he could complete it forwards and backwards. On the first attempt, Ward recited the alphabet from A to V, and then froze, unable to finish the task as instructed.

Due to the above listed investigation, I found Probable Cause to arrest and charge Ward with Driving Under the Influence. Ward was placed into handcuffs which were double locked, stacked, and checked for proper fit. I then placed Ward into the back of my patrol vehicle, and later transported him to the Palm Beach County BAT facility. While in the back of my vehicle, Ward made a spontaneous statement that he felt that he was not that intoxicated, and stated that he was probably only slightly over the legal limit, stating he was likely a .09, and would like the opportunity to provide a breath sample.

Ward was transported to the BAT facility and later provided two breath samples, both of which were two times over the legal limit. It should be noted, that although Ward had multiple mood swings, that he was cooperative and polite, during my entire encounter with him. Ward was later turned over to jail staff without further incident. This case is cleared by arrest.

D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

ON THE 18TH DAY OF MARCH 20 18, AT 2330 AM PM

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On the above date and time, I was on routine patrol, driving my clearly marked PBSO patrol vehicle, North on Garden Rd. from Investment Ln. in unincorporated Riviera Beach, when I observed a red F-150 Pick up with Florida License plate Y14VXT, driving North on Garden Rd. From Investment, with no working tag light. As I approached the vehicle from the rear, I observed the vehicle turn West onto Consumer St. from Garden Rd., and once completing the turn, I observed the vehicle swerve into the lanes of oncoming traffic, and then back into the West bound lane. As I went to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle after observing the tag light was out, I observed the vehicle again, swerve to the left, into the East bound lanes of travel, and then back into the West bound lanes of travel. Upon viewing the previously mentioned moving violation, and the fact that the vehicle could not maintain its lane, I conducted a traffic stop. The vehicle stopped just West of the intersection of Consumer St. and Currency Dr. in unincorporated Riviera Beach.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Once the vehicle stopped, I exited my patrol vehicle and made a driver side approach to conduct the traffic stop. As I made contact with the driver, He later identified himself as Tyler Ward, W/M 12/24/92, and is the suspect in this case. As I made contact with the driver, I could immediately smell the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath, which intensified as he spoke with me. While speaking with Ward, I noticed that his speech was slurred, low, thick, and at times difficult to understand. As I asked Ward to provide me with his Driver's License and his vehicle registration, I observed his movements were slow and lethargic. Ward also made large swinging movements with his arms, and fumbled with his registration paperwork while continuing to look for it. I also observed that Ward's eyes were glossy and bloodshot, and while speaking with him, Ward would lose track of the conversation and drift off while speaking with me.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Shortly after initiating the above listed traffic stop, Ward informed me that he would like his vehicle towed, and requested that I call him a taxi. When I asked Ward why he would like me to call him a taxi, he stated that he knew he was wrong. I asked Ward where he was coming from, and he first stated that he was coming from his home in Lake Park. I asked Ward why he was in a closed industrial area, driving around at 2330 hours at night, to which he informed me that he was on his way home. Ward later changed his story, stating that he was on his way home from a friend's house, who lives close by in Lake Park, and that he went out of his way to the industrial area to look at a place he wanted to work. I asked Ward how much he had to drink that evening, and he informed me that he had two Natural Ice beers, approximately one hour prior to driving. He also stated that he had eaten some Tacos prior to drinking.

ODORS:

Obvious odor of an unidentified alcoholic beverage, which intensified as they spoke

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: Slow, Slurred, Thick, and at times difficult to understand

ATTITUDE: Mood Swings from Compliant to Crying, and Aggitated

CLOTHING: Gray shirt, white shorts, black shoes.

HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS:

- LT EYE-LACK OF SMOOTH PURSUIT

Other Observations:

Ward later changed his story and stated that he had three beers, and then later changed his story again stating he had up to four beers at his friend's house. After speaking with Ward in his vehicle, I asked him to step out, and informed him that I had observed multiple signs of impairment, and would be requesting him to participate in road side tasks. Once I asked Ward to step out of the vehicle, he fumbled around looking for his keys to shut the truck off for over one minute, and then looked around before placing them in the center consol. Ward then started off, and took a few minutes to get out of his vehicle.

WALK & TURN:

Once Ward exited his vehicle, he began stumbling and had an uneven gate as he walked towards the front of my vehicle. I asked Ward to remove his hat and glasses, and began conducting roadside tasks. Ward informed me that he did not have any medical disabilities that would affect his balance or speech. I asked Ward if he was color blind, to which he informed me that he was not. I then asked Ward what color the light pen I was holding was, and he informed me correctly that it was red. I instructed and later demonstrated to Ward to reach out with his right pointer finger when instructed, and touch the tip of the light pen. Ward attempted to do this, and missed the tip of the light pen, eventually making contact with the light and the left side of his finger. I instructed Ward on how to perform the HGN task, and he informed me that he understood. Ward showed obvious signs of impairment with the HGN task, and had lack of smooth pursuit, distinct and sustained Nystagmus at Max deviation, and onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 degrees, in both eyes. After completing the HGN task, I informed Ward that I would be instructing him on how to perform the Walk and Turn Task. I instructed and then demonstrated to Ward on how to get into the starting position. Ward stated that he understood the instructions, and then attempted to get into the starting position. Ward placed his right foot in front of his left foot, and missed heel to toe. Almost immediately Ward lost his balance and stepped out of the starting position.

ONE LEG STAND:

Ward made multiple attempts to get into the starting position, but lost his balance almost immediately each time. Ward eventually stopped attempting to get into the starting position, and stared off. I asked Ward if he wanted to participate in the roadside tasks, and he verbally stated that he wanted to. When I instructed Ward to get into the starting position again, he had a mood swing and began to cry, requesting that his vehicle be towed and he be allowed to get a ride. I asked Ward again if he wanted to participate in the roadside tasks, to which he stated he did, but would not get into the starting position. Ward was then read his Taylor Warnings, and informed that he was not participating in the roadside tasks. Ward verbally stated that he wanted to participate, and attempted again to enter the starting position. Ward again, lost his balance immediately. Due to the fact that Ward could not safely get into the starting position for the walk and turn task, I asked him if he wanted to move onto another task, to which he stated that he did.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I then instructed and then demonstrated for Ward, how to perform the one legged stand task. It should be noted that while in the starting position for this task, Ward swayed from side to side, and back to front greater than two inches. After explaining and demonstrating the task, Ward informed me that he understood the instructions. Once Ward was instructed to begin, he lost his balance and put his foot down multiple times, swayed from side to side, put his arms out for support, and bounced up and down. Ward requested to be given a second chance to complete the task, and on the second attempt, he swayed from side to side, bounced up and down, bent over around the waist, put his foot down multiple times, did not look at his foot while counting, and continued attempting the task after being instructed to stop.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

Upon completion of the One Leg Stand task, I instructed Ward, and then demonstrated how to perform the Finger to Nose task to him. Ward stated that he understood the instructions, and was told to begin the task. The order I used for this task was L,R,L,R,R,L. When instructed to use his right finger to touch his nose, Ward missed the tip of his nose each time, touching the upper part of his lip, and then moving to the underside of his nose. When the order was changed, Ward delayed his response, and eventually raised the correct hand. On the last order, Ward left his finger on his nose for a longer period of time.
