


D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

ON THE 7 DAY OF OCTOBER 20 17, AT 2209 AM PM

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On Saturday, October 6, 2017 at approximately 2218 hours, I was dispatched to 6346 Lantana Road, Lake Worth (Palm Beach County) Florida to assist Deputy A Sentz with a traffic crash that involved a possible drunk driver. Upon my arrival I noticed D/S Sentz standing on the driver side of a white vehicle. There was a female sitting in the driver seat of the vehicle with the engine on. I made contact with D/S Sentz who told me the following: On 10/07/2015 at 2211 hours I was dispatched to the area of 6346 Lantana Rd. behind the business complex, unincorporated Lake Worth, FL, 33463 in reference an accident involving a possible intoxicated female. PBSO communications received a call stating that a white car had collided with a red parked vehicle. Upon my arrival I was directed by several bystanders to a white Cadillac CTS bearing FL Tag # Z13AMW parked behind the Doll Factory Unit #62 at the above address. The vehicle was running and had front right end damage with red paint transfer marks. I attempted to make contact with the white female who refused to roll down the window and gave me a blank stare. I identified myself and opened the drivers. Upon opening the door I smelt a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on her breath. I instructed the female to turn off the vehicle to which she complied. The female later identified as Uyen Nguyen appeared extremely intoxicated, was slurring her words, and was very belligerent. The female denied hitting any parked cars and stated that she was on her way home to her kids. The investigation was then turned over to D/S White # 7209 with the DUI unit: D/S Sentz wrote a sworn witness statement on a probable cause affidavit with information regarding this incident.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I made contact with the driver who was sitting in the driver seat of the previously mentioned vehicle. She was later identified as Uyen Kim Nguyen by her Florida driver license. During my interview I noticed the her eyes were red, watery and glossy. Her speech was slurred, mouth was dry and cheeks were flushed. Her lips were chapped and she seemed upset. I could smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from the inside of the vehicle. I explained to the driver that her vehicle struck a park car and left the scene. Moreover I told her she had red paint on her front bumper that was consistent with the park vehicle that is also red. D/S Sentz completed a crash report. I later explained that I had a suspicion she had been drinking an unspecified amount of unknown alcoholic beverages. She later told me she had two (2) drinks but was not drunk. I asked her to step out of the vehicle. Upon doing so she immediately lost her balance and began swaying. She staggered on occasion and began swearing at a man standing in the rear of a restaurant. She later explained the man was her husband. Two children were also standing by the man. Nguyen began cursing her husband. Based on my suspicion of her alcoholic beverage consumption I asked if she would consent to performing Standardized Field Sobriety Evaluations (SFSTs) for the purpose of determining if he was impaired while operating a motor vehicle. She began cursing at me and pushed me in the chest once. She got back into her vehicle and started it up. We had to pull her out of the vehicle in fear she would drive off. Once out of the vehicle I asked if she would perform the SFSTs. She seemed agitated and screamed she would. I tried escorting her to a smooth surface that was well lighted by street lights, obviously, however, she just stared at me. I asked if she had any physical problems with her body that would inhibit her from performing light physical exercises. I also asked if she was taking medication. She told me she neither had anything wrong with her physically, nor was she taking medication. I could now smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her breath that intensified when she spoke. I asked her to walk over to an area inside the parking lot. Nguyen hastily started walking toward the area and nearly fell into the wall. She stopped and once again stared at me. Since she was not cooperating I gave the Taylor Warnings and explained the SFSTs were voluntary and she did not have to perform them; however, the evidence that I already had against her (all the previously mentioned indicators) would be strong basis for her being arrested if she chose not to perform the SFSTs. Additionally I explained her non cooperation would be used against her in a court of law. She was not phased by the warnings and tried to run pass me to get to her husband. At this time I restrained her in handcuffs and told her she was being placed under lawful arrest for DUI and leaving the scene of a traffic crash with property damage. I needed assistance to restrain her in handcuffs. While trying to seat her in the back seat of my patrol car she began bracing and kicking to keep from being placed in the back seat. She cursed at me and started spitting at me. He spit missed me and landed on the back window of my car. We had to place a spit mask over her face to prevent her from trying to spit again. We struggled to seatbelt her in the back seat. Sometime later we properly placed her in the seatbelt.






