P	<p>On 04/04/17, at 0032 hours, I was conducting patrol in my marked patrol vehicle in the area of South Central Boulevard and Jupiter Gardens Boulevard. I observed a red 2005 Hyundai Sport Utility Vehicle bearing Florida tag EGKQ55 pull out onto South Central Boulevard to go north from Jupiter Gardens Boulevard. I am aware from my training and experience that the area the vehicle was coming from, Kennedy Estates, is an area frequented by many people to buy drugs. I noticed that the right tag light on the vehicle was out, making it difficult to see the right side of the license plate. I conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle for the aforementioned non-moving violation at the intersection of West Indiantown Road and Interstate 95.</p>			
R	<p>I made contact with the driver, Valerie L. Kirtley (w/f 01/22/82), and the front seat passenger, Croix I. Carpenter (w/f 07/14/98). I identified myself and explained the reason for the traffic stop. As Kirtley was searching for her registration and insurance card that I requested to see, I asked her what she was doing with Croix in the Jupiter area. Kirtley responded that they were just hanging out with a guy she just met back in Kennedy Estates but could not advise what street he lived on. I asked her if there were any drugs in the vehicle and she said, "No."</p>			
O	<p>Once my backup unit arrived, MPO Banegas #328, I asked Kirtley to step out of the vehicle. I explained to her that the area she was coming out of is known for being a place to buy crack cocaine. Kirtley told me that she has never done drugs and was not in the area to purchase any. I asked Kirtley if I had her consent to search her car, to which she replied, "No, I really don't want you to because it's such a mess". I then told her that I was going to check and see if there was a K9 Officer available to come by and have the dog walk around the vehicle. Upon hearing this, Kirtley advised me that there was a "one-hitter" used for smoking marijuana in the center console along with a small amount of marijuana.</p>

I then asked Carpenter to step out of the vehicle so I could retrieve the smoking device and marijuana from the center console. I opened the center console from the passenger side of the vehicle and located a white a brown, plastic cylindrical object that resembled a cigarette. The end of the object had burnt residue with the odor, which I recognized from training and experience, of marijuana emanating from it. MPO Banegas was on the driver's side of the vehicle and told me that there was "shake", a term used to describe small pieces of marijuana, on the driver's side floor board. The marijuana shake in plain view along with the absence of marijuana that was supposed to be in the center console gave me probable cause to believe that there was illegal contraband somewhere else in the vehicle.

Wedged in between the driver's seat and the center console was a plastic miniature vodka bottle. There was aluminum foil wrapped around the top and neck of the bottle and there was a hole on the side. There was also burnt residue on the inside of the bottle. I recognized this object, through my training and experience, to be a smoking device used for inhaling crack cocaine.

I located a Newport cigarette pack next to where the smoking device was found in between the seat and the center console. Inside the cigarette pack there were four white crack rocks which were later field tested positive for crack cocaine.

Upon discovering the crack cocaine and smoking devices in Kirtley's constructive possession, I placed her under arrest. She was placed into handcuffs in the rear that were double-locked and checked for proper spacing. I then read Kirtley her Miranda Rights and began to ask her questions. I asked her why she did not tell me about the crack pipe or the crack rocks and she said she did not know. She admitted that the pipe was used for smoking crack. I asked her how long she has been smoking crack and she replied, "Like two months". She advised me that she just bought the crack before she was stopped but did not know which street she bought it on. She told me that one black male came to her car and sold her the crack for \$40.00. Kirtley said all of the crack and the smoking device were hers and not Carpenter's.

MPO Banegas read Carpenter her Miranda Rights. She told him that she gave Kirtley \$20.00 to put towards the crack cocaine so they could split it. She advised him that she and Kirtley went to Kennedy Estates together in Kirtley's vehicle and that one black male came to the vehicle and sold them the crack. She could not advise what street they went to. She admitted to MPO Banegas that the crack was both of theirs and that they were going to smoke it together.

Carpenter was then placed under arrest and put into handcuffs in the rear which were double-locked and checked for proper spacing.

Officer Pope #352 arrived on scene to search both Kirtley and Carpenter incident to

Kirtley was later asked what the bottle was used for, to which she replied, "Smoking weed".</p> <p>I found probable cause to charge Valerie Kirtley for Possession of a Controlled Substance (Cocaine) without a Prescription, pursuant to FSS 893.13(6)(A) and for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, pursuant to FSS 893.147. Kirtley was also issued a traffic citation for Improper Equipment (tag light).</p>
