PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

I responded to 100 S. Golfview in the City of Lake Worth, Florida in reference to a vehicle driving erratically around Bryant Park. Upon my arrival, I located a red four-door Hyundai bearing Florida tag GASB10 stopped at the entrance to part of the parking lot. Myself and responding deputies approached the vehicle, and observed the sole occupant as a white female, later identified by Florida driver's license as Veronica Lopez, sitting in the driver seat. Lopez was struggling with the gear shifter, and unaware of our presence around her vehicle. The car was still in drive, and I knocked on the window and asked her to put it in park. She did not respond, so another deputy opened the car door. Lopez finally placed the vehicle in park, and I asked her to step out of the car so I could speak to her.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Prior to asking Lopez to exit the vehicle, the odor of alcohol emanated strongly from the interior of the vehicle. Lopez's eyes were extremely bloodshot, and she was having trouble focusing her vision on myself or any of the other deputies on scene. As she exited the vehicle and I began speaking to her, the odor of alcohol from her mouth grew stronger with each word spoken. Lopez was unable to stand still, swaying from side to side and looking around as if she did not know where she was and wanted to leave where she was standing. While speaking with Lopez, her behavior changed rapidly. One second she was crying hysterically, the next she was screaming and cussing loudly at myself for "interrogating her like a criminal".

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Lopez stated she had been at a bar just prior to our encounter, but was unable to name the bar or give a general location of where the bar was located. She stated multiple times she did not know how she got to the exact location we were standing at. It was brought to her attention that her vehicle had damage to the front passenger side, as if she sideswiped something in her travels. She kept calling the damage "a bump" and repeatedly said she did not hit something and has no idea how the damage got there. Lopez did state she had 3 glasses of wine at the bar, as well as another drink at Flanagan's after the first bar. When asked if she thought she should be operating a motor vehicle, she advised she should not have been.

Strong odor of alcoholic beverage

Other Observations:

Lopez struggled to maintain the instructional stance across the board. She stopped multiple times during each test, crying hysterically and attempting to regain her composure.

WALK & TURN:

Lopez struggled greatly with getting into the initial instructional stance. She swayed all over the roadway, and had to cant her front foot sideways in order to find her balance. She failed to maintain a heel-to-toe walk, taking multiple small steps per each step forward in order to keep her foot on the gray duct taped line. She did not follow the small series of steps to turn 180 degrees as instructed, but rather picked her foot up off the ground and turned around in a circle at her leisure. Lopez also failed to complete only 9 steps forward and 9 steps back.

ONE LEG STAND:

Lopez failed to keep her hands down at her side during the task. She raised both hands up to keep her balance. When she initially started the task, she picked her foot up, counted a few numbers, and placed it back down. When she picked her foot back up, she started over at 1 instead of continuing where she left off. She placed her foot on the ground multiple times throughout the task. When she reached 20, she jumped to 30 and 40 and then went back to counting from 31 on past 40.

FINGER TO NOSE:

Lopez initially failed to bring her hand back down to her side as instructed, and had to be told to place her hand down instead of keeping it on her nose. She failed to touch only the tip of her finger to the tip of her nose, making contact with the side of her nose/face a few times. There was also a delay in my instruction to lift a certain hand and her responding; if I said right, she would start to move her left hand and then realize it was incorrect and switch over to the right hand.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

Lopez did not struggle with this task.


