D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

ON THE 08 DAY OF May 2012 AT 0528 [X] A.M [X] P.M.

PERSONAL CONTACT/DRIVING PATTERN/OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

On the above date and time, Officers were dispatched to Checkers parking lot 755 W. Boynton Beach Blvd. in reference to a motor vehicle crash (vehicle vs. pole). This location is in the City of Boynton Beach, Palm Beach County Florida.

Upon my arrival I spoke with Officers who stated that while investigation a single crash the driver of a 2007 Lexus bearing Florida tag BEST86 was possibly impaired. I first spoke with William Peterson d.o.b 02/08/57 who was working inside the business at the time of the crash. Peterson stated that he observed the black in color Lexus drive into the parking lot. Peterson identified the operator as the female with blonde hair. The Lexus entered the drive thru (business closed) east side of the building. Peterson then made contact with the blonde female outside and told her the business was closed. Peterson was in his Ecolab business uniform. The driver then pulled into the west side drive thru and knocked on the window. Peterson again made contact with the Blonde Female who asked why he was in the business. A couple minutes later Peterson felt the building shake and looked out to see the same Lexus against the concrete pole. The blonde female was outside the vehicle trying to pry the bumper off the pole. The front passenger was still inside the vehicle in the front passenger seat.

Peterson completed a sworn written statement to the above facts.

I then spoke with the owner/front passenger W/F Shannon Kiesner who stated that she was too drunk to drive and let her girlfriend W/F Whitney L. Collins driver d.o.b. 05/31/87. Kiesner also provided a sworn written statement to the above information. I then made contact with Collins who crawled from the rear left seat to the right front seat of the vehicle. Collins admitted to operating the vehicle at first but when I activated the video and audio system, Collins recanted her statement. I advised Collins of her constitutional right per Miranda. Collins began walking on the taped line I put down on the ground, telling me that it was "pretty good" as far as she was concerned as a "normal citizen". As I was speaking to Collins, she walked over to the curb and sat down. I had to ask her to walk back over to me and continue what I was saying. Collins stated the she understood the Miranda rights and agreed to perform a series of SFST's. Again Collins began walking back and forth on the tape line, without receiving any instructions. Once she walked back over to me, I completed the HGN task.

The following indicators were detected on the SFST's:

HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS:

- [X] Left eye does not follow smoothly
[X] Left eye prior to 45 degrees
[X] Distinct jerking in left eye at maximum deviation
[] Vertical Nystagmus in left eye

- [X] Right eye does not follow smoothly
[X] Right eye prior to 45 degrees
[X] Distinct jerking in right eye at maximum deviation
[] Vertical Nystagmus in right eye

WALK AND TURN:

THIS TASK WAS EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO Collins, who stated she understood. Collins failed to allow me to explain the task to begin, walked away and sat down on the curb, walked back and forth before receiving full instructions, stopped the task for failure to comply.

ONE LEG STAND:

THIS TASK WAS EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO Collins, who stated she understood. Started on the right leg then switched to the left leg, started before receiving full instructions, stopped the task due to failure to comply.

FINGER TO NOSE:

THIS TASK WAS EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO Collins, who stated she understood. Began task before receiving full instructions, raised he right finger up and stopped without attempting to touch her nose, stopped the task due to failure to comply.

ROMBERG/ALPHABET:

THIS TASK WAS NOT ATTEMPTED DUE TO LEVEL OF INTOXICATION.

Collins was taken into custody and transported to the BBPD booking facility. At the booking facility I completed the required 20-minute observation. Collin was extremely uncooperative through out the booking process. Collins spoke over my voice, telling to call her Mom because her father was suffering from ALS and he was going to die. Collins attempted to take her Massachusetts driver's license of the desk, demanding I return the license to her. Once the 20-minute observation was completed I requested Collins provide a sample of her breath for the purpose of determining the alcohol content, which Collins refused. I read implied consent to Collins who stated that she did not understand. I explained this in plain terms, which stated that she did not understand. Collins finally walked over to the chair, stated that on no terms will she provide a sample. A then made a second request which was also declined.

Based on the aforementioned information I have established probable cause to charge W/F Whitney L. Collins with one count of DUI pursuant to FSS 316.193(1). Collins was processed, medically cleared at Bethesda. Collins was then transported to Palm Beach County jail.
