**PROBABLE CAUSE**

On the above date and time, I was responding as a backup Trooper (Tpr) to a traffic stop Tpr. Z. Todd (1729) initiated. Once on scene, Tpr. Z. Todd advised me that while he was traveling westbound on Okeechobee Blvd, he observed a pair of vehicle headlights traveling eastbound, towards him in the westbound lanes. As the headlight vehicle headlights got closer, Tpr. Z. Todd advised me that he turned on his emergency lights and sirens in an attempt to get the drivers attention. Tpr. Z. Todd advised me that the vehicle then made a U-turn and began to correctly travel westbound. Tpr. Z. Todd then initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle. Tpr. Z. Todd advised me while speaking to the driver of the vehicle that was traveling the wrong way, he observed signs of possible impairment. I then became the primary DUI Trooper on scene. I then approached the vehicle and began to speak with the driver, who was later identified by his Texas Driver's License number 14946084 as William Greenfield. I asked Mr. Greenfield to exit the vehicle. Mr. Greenfield complied and did so. I then escorted Mr. Greenfield over to in front of my marked patrol vehicle. Once there, I began to speak with Mr. Greenfield about why he was pulled over. Mr. Greenfield advised that he was driving the wrong way because he is from Texas and wasn't familiar with the roadway in Florida. While speaking to Mr. Greenfield, I observed him to have red glassy eyes, and an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the mouth and breath area of Mr. Greenfield. I asked Mr. Greenfield did he consume any alcoholic beverages prior to/ while driving. Mr. Greenfield advised that he consumed three (3) beers earlier. I then asked Mr. Greenfield if he would perform a series of Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE's). Mr. Greenfield agreed to submit. Prior to beginning the exercises it was determined Mr. Greenfield was not wearing contacts. Mr. Greenfield were checked and his eyes equal tracking and his pupils were equal sizes. Mr. Greenfield instructed to following the stimulus with his eyes only, keeping his head still. After stating he understood the instructions Mr. Greenfield attempted this exercise.

The results of this exercise displayed 6 of the 6 possible clues.

- A lack of Smooth Pursuit in his left eye.
- A lack of Smooth Pursuit in his right eye.
- A distinct and sustained nystagmus in the left eye at maximum deviation.
- A distinct and sustained nystagmus in the right eye at maximum deviation.
- An onset of nystagmus in the left eye prior to 45 degrees.
- An onset of nystagmus in the right eye prior to 45 degrees.

The exercise further revealed the presence of vertical nystagmus. Vertical nystagmus is an indicator of high doses of alcohol, other central nervous system (CNS) depressants or inhalants, and the consumption of the drug phencyclidine (PCP).

While performing the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus exercise, it was observed that Mr. Greenfield:

- Had difficulty following and responding to instructions.
- Moved his head from side to side during the exercise.
- Swayed while standing.
- The instructions for the exercise had to be repeated before Mr. Greenfield would respond

Walk and Turn exercise

Prior to attempting this exercise, Mr. Greenfield indicated he did not have any medical problems that would have prevented him from performing the exercise. Mr. Greenfield advised that he was able to walk an imaginary line. Mr. Greenfield instructed to put his left foot on the line and his right foot in front of it with his right heel touching the toe of his left foot. He was instructed to stand in this manner with his hands to his sides until the exercise instructions were completed and the exercise demonstrated. Mr. Greenfield was instructed not to begin the exercise until told to start. He was instructed to take nine steps along the line in a heel-to-toe manner. After the ninth step he was to stop and turn around keeping his lead foot on the ground, taking several small steps with the other foot to turn around. After turning around he was to take nine steps in a heel-to-toe manner back along the line, in the direction he had come from. Mr. Greenfield was further instructed to watch his feet at all times while walking, keep his arms down to his side, and to count his steps out loud. After the exercise was demonstrated Mr. Greenfield stated he understood the instructions and was instructed to begin the exercise.

- After attempting the Walk and Turn exercise Mr. Greenfield displayed 5 of 8 possible clues.

Walk and Turn exercise observations:

- On the first set of steps Mr. Greenfield failed to walk in a heel-to-toe manner on 1,2,8,9 steps, - On the second set of step Mr. Greenfield failed to walk in a heel-to-toe manner on 2,3,6,8,9 steps, -
- Unable to stand heel to toe.
- Turned incorrectly.
- Used hand for balance
- Did not watch feet during exercise

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**One Leg Stand exercise**

Prior to attempting this exercise, Mr. Greenfield indicated he did not have any medical problems that would have prevented him from performing the exercise. Mr. Greenfield was instructed to stand with his heels together and hands down to his sides while the instructions were given and during the exercise. Mr. Greenfield was instructed not to begin the exercise until he was instructed to start, and after the exercise had been demonstrated. When instructed to start, he was to raise the foot of his choice off the ground approximately 6 inches. While his leg was raised he was to keep his leg straight, watch his raised foot, and to count out loud by thousands (one thousand one, one thousand two, one thousand three...) and to continue the exercise until told to stop (30 seconds). After this exercise was demonstrated and indicating he understood the instructions Mr. Greenfield attempted this exercise.

When Mr. Greenfield attempted this exercise he raised his right foot.

The result of this exercise displayed 3 of the 4 possible clues.

During this exercise Mr. Greenfield:

- Swayed during the exercise.
- Used arms for balance.
- Put his foot down (2 time(s) during the exercise).

**Modified Finger to Nose**

I asked Mr. Greenfield to place his hands out to his side at a 45 degree angle close his palms, except his index finger. After doing so, I advised Mr. Greenfield when asked, to close his eyes and lean his head back. I will then call out left, or right (hand). Once I call out left or right hand, he was to touch the tip of his nose. Not his nostril, or bridge of his nose. Mr. Greenfield touched the tip of his nose, he was to return his hand to starting position (to the side at approximately 45 degrees) Mr. Greenfield advised he understood. Once started, Mr. Greenfield touched the bridge of his then moved his index finger to the tip of his nose on each request, then correctly performed the exercise as requested. Once I concluded the Finger to nose exercise.

\*While observing Mr. Greenfield during this exercise, I observed an unknown white powdered substance around and in Mr. Greenfield nose.

I then demonstrated to Mr. Greenfield the Modified Romberg Balance exercise. I advised Mr. Greenfield when asked to begin, to stand with his feet together, keep his hands down by his side, lean his head back and close his eyes. After doing so, Mr. Greenfield was instructed to estimate the passage of 30 seconds in Mr. Greenfield head without counting out loud, and when finished to open his eyes, bring his head back to a neutral position and say done. Mr. Greenfield advised he understood. Mr. Greenfield then began the exercise. Mr. Greenfield advised he was done at approximately 24 seconds.

After I completed the Standardize Field Sobriety Exercise observations on Mr. Greenfield, I then placed Mr. Greenfield under arrest for suspected DUI. I then placed Mr. Greenfield in the rear of my patrol vehicle. Shortly after, I departed the scene enroute to the Palm Beach County Jail. Upon arrival at the jail, I escorted Mr. Greenfield to the BAT center. There, I conducted a 20 minute observation period of Mr. Greenfield. Once the 20 minutes were up, I escorted Mr. Greenfield into the BAT room. Once there, I requested Mr. Greenfield to submit to a lawful test of his breath for the purpose of determining its alcohol content Mr. Greenfield refused to do so. I then advised Mr. Greenfield of Florida Implied Consent. Mr. Greenfield advised he understood and continued to refuse. After, I then advised Mr. Greenfield of his Constitutional Warnings. Mr. Greenfield advised he understood. No Q&A was conducted. After, I then transported Mr. Greenfield to booking into the Palm Beach County Jail. Shortly after, Mr. Greenfield was booked into the Palm Beach County jail on 316.193.1 Florida Statue. All events occurred in Palm Beach County.

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
