On the September 5, 2019, at approximately 2:46am, I was in service in Palm Beach County, Florida. I was dispatched by the Lake Worth Regional Communication Center to the area of southbound Interstate 95 (State Road 9), exit ramp to Woolbright Road. The call was in reference to Boynton Beach Officer Acosta ID# 978 who stopped out with a White in color 4-Door Honda Accord who was blocking

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the left lane of the exit ramp with a driver slumped over asleep at the wheel while the vehicle was running.

I arrived on scene and met with Officer Acosta who gave a sworn statement on my in-car dashboard camera stating that he was behind the white Honda at the southbound Interstate 95 (State Road 9), exit ramp to Woolbright Road. Officer Acosta stated that after the vehicle did not move after the traffic signal had cycled, he conducted a traffic stop and got out to check on the driver of the vehicle. When he approached the White Honda on the Driver side he observed a white male in the driver seat to be the sole occupant in the vehicle. Officer Acosta stated that the driver was asleep behind the wheel and nonresponsive even after knocking on the window multiple times. The driver finally woke up and Officer Acosta stated that he had the driver exit the vehicle so he could turn off the vehicle and take possession of the vehicle due to the fact that he believed the driver was possibly under the influence based upon his observations of the driver.

The Driver was identified by his Florida Photo Driver's License as YURI CHEREMETIEV and was ran through FCIC/NCIC and was clear of any warrants. The four door white Honda with TAG#5643UU was also ran through FCIC/NCIC and was not missing or stolen.

I then approached the vehicle from the driver side and made contact with a White Male in the driver seat, CHEREMETIEV. I observed the CHEREMETIEV to be slumped over again asleep. I stated the driver's name multiple times through the open window, still the driver was nonresponsive but did not appear to have trouble breathing. I then reached in the vehicle to rub the driver's chest region, it was at this time that the driver woke up. I asked the driver he was okay to which he stated "yes". While utilizing my flashlight I was able to observe the driver had bloodshot and glassy eyes and spoke with a slurred speech. I also smelled the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from the vehicle. I then asked CHEREMETIEV to exit his vehicle. When CHEREMETIEV exited his vehicle he stumbled along the side of his vehicle having difficulty standing.

I then asked CHEREMETIEV to stand in front of my patrol car which was blocking the right lane of the exit ramp to ensure our safety from traffic. I then proceeded to ask CHEREMETIEV where he was going to which he stated that he was on his way to Palm Beach from Palm Beach. I asked CHEREMETIEV if he knew where he was, to which he stated "in Delray". I then asked CHEREMETIEV, based off of my observations, that I believe he may be under the influence and if he would be willing to perform roadside exercises to check for impairment to which CHEREMETIEV agreed that he would do the exercises. Before beginning the exercises, I asked CHEREMETIEV if he had any head injuries or anything wrong with his eyes to which he responded "No".

Other Observations:

- CHEREMETIEV was having a difficult time keeping head still during task, even after saying that he

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understood not to move his head. I also observed that the driver had bloodshot, glassy, and watery eyes. CHEREMETIEV had equal tracking and equal pupil size. Odor of unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from CHEREMETIEV's breath and person. CHEREMETIEV also had a forward and back as well as orbital sway while standing. CHEREMETIEV also stopped following the light and looked at me having to be told to follow the light multiple times. Subject repeatedly looked back at me when instructed to follow light and stated that he was looking at the light.

Walk and Turn-

CHEREMETIEV was asked if he had any injuries or pains that would prevent him performing an exercise that requires walking, to which he/she responded "No" but that he did have a previous shoulder injury. CHEREMETIEV could not keep balance while listening to instructions and came out of starting position. CHEREMETIEV missed walking heel-to-toe multiple times. CHEREMETIEV stepped off the line multiple times on both times he walked down the line. CHEREMETIEV utilized his arms for balance during exercise. CHEREMETIEV turned improperly (Turned opposite directions then instructed). CHEREMETIEV also took improper number, 20 steps on first walk and 21 steps on second walk.

One-Leg Stand-

CHEREMETIEV was asked if he had any injuries or pains that would prevent him performing an exercise that requires him to lift one leg, to which he responded, "No". CHEREMETIEV swayed during exercise as well as put his foot down multiple times during exercise. CHEREMETIEV also had to use his arms for balance during the exercise. CHEREMETIEV also failed to keep his elevated and standing leg straight during exercise. CHEREMETIEV elevated his foot as well as restarted counting multiple times after putting his foot down after counting to 10 out loud.

After concluding the roadside exercises, I advised CHEREMETIEV that he was being placed under arrest for Driving under the influence based on the totality of the circumstances. CHEREMETIEV was placed in handcuffs and was searched and placed into the rear of my patrol vehicle. CHEREMETIEV was transported to the Palm Beach County Jail.

While at the breath testing facility, CHEREMETIEV was read implied consent and was requested to provide samples of his breath in order to determine the alcohol content, to which he stated that he did not want to do the breath test. CHEREMETIEV was reminded of this and the consequence were clarified to him. He then refused again. CHEREMETIEV was read her Miranda Rights and stated that he understood his rights. With his rights in mind CHEREMETIEV invoked his right to counsel and stated that he did not want to answer any questions.

My in-car video was activated to capture the location of where CHEREMETIEV's vehicle was at time of stop, witness statement by Boynton Beach Officer Acosta ID# 978 and the roadside sobriety exercises of CHEREMETIEV. Reference Boynton Beach Police Department Case# 19050185.

The above incident occurred in Palm Beach County, Florida.
