PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)
I responded to the area of 200 Old English Drive in reference to a just occurred vehicle crash. I made contact with the investigating officer in the crash, Officer Turner. Officer Turner advised me that a witness, Mason Colling (05-30-88), observed Yvonne Propper driving her vehicle west through the parking lot. Colling saw Propper strike a recycling bin and a parked car before continuing west through the parking lot. Officer Turner advised that he observed signs of impairment during the crash investigation.

I made contact with Propper, who was standing with Officer Hobby. I had Propper walk to the front of my vehicle and informed her the crash investigation was complete and I was starting a DUI investigation. I read Propper her Miranda Rights from a prepared text which she indicated she understood. Propper agreed to complete SFSTs.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Propper had glassy eyes. Propper stood very close to me and I had to back up several times to gain normal personal space. Propper was swaying while standing still.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Propper stated that a child from the neighborhood jumped out in front of her car, causing her to swerve. Propper struck garbage on the curb and a car. Propper stated she continued to drive so she could locate and yell at the child that allegedly caused the crash. Propper stated she had consumed a beer after the crash at either her friend's house or with her child's father. Both Denise Defalco (neighbor) and Roger Tompkins were unable to verify this account. Propper repeatedly denied drinking otherwise.

Odor of unknown alcoholic beverage on breath



Other Observations:

Propper had trouble following the directions and had to be reminded several times to keep head still. Was swaying visibly during the task.

WALK & TURN:

Propper lost her balance during the instructions phase. Propper used her arms for balance on the first step. Propper missed heel to toe on the 3rd, 4th, and 5th steps. Propper used her arms for balance and stopped for balance on the 7th step. Propper missed heel to toe on the 9th step. Propper turned by pivoting on the balls of her feet while having her arms away from her sides (more than 6 inches). Propper used her arms for balance during the entire return leg. Propper missed heel to toe on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, and 9th steps.

ONE LEG STAND:

Propper started counting improperly and corrected herself around 1000-4. Propper was not looking at her foot. I directed her to look at her foot. Propper used her arms for balance and stepped back on 1000-8. Propper was swaying visibly during this time and prior to putting her foot down. Propper started over and put her foot down on 1000-2 while using her arms for balance. Propper put her foot down while using her arms for balance again shortly after. Propper switched feet and stood on her left foot. Propper put her foot down immediately while using her arms for balance. Propper counted to 1000-8 before I terminated the task due to time expiring.

FINGER TO NOSE

L1: Propper touched the tip of her nose with the pad of her finger. R2: Propper touched the tip of her nose with the pad of her finger. L3: Propper touched the tip of her nose with the pad of her finger. R4: Propper touched the tip of her nose with the pad of her finger. R5: Propper touched her nose with her left finger before switching and touching the tip of her nose with the pad of her finger. L6: Propper touched the tip of her nose with the pad of her finger.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

Propper was swaying during the task. Propper stated the alphabet correctly.


